To support the Marines travelling from Camp Pendleton to RDU Airport and then to Camp Lejeune, the Knights of Columbus, Pope John Paul II Assembly 3017, Kernersville, NC , in conjunction with Operation Jersey Cares Organization, Somerville, NJ will be donating to the RDU USO: Girl Scout Cookies (GSC) and Welch's Fruit Snacks.

This donation will include the following:

276 GSC boxes of Thin Mints
