

2019 ANNUAL REPORT OF ST. JOSEPH'S CWL We quilted 20 quilts from November to



April for our major fundraiser at the Douro Doings. We worked with the Knights of Columbus at the Douro Doings. We provided lunch for seven funeral receptions. We arranged two Out of the Cold dinners in Peterborough. Two members attended the Peterborough Diocese annual CWL convention. We made a \$1500 donation towards the insurance premium for the hall. We gave donations

to Quilts for Cancer and donations to four parishioners dealing with medical issues. We provided money for lunch for the First communion and Confirmation classes. We gave prayer cards to students making their First Communion and Confirmation. Grade 8 students were given crucifixes. We hosted a tea for CWL members with 25, 40, 50 and 60 years of service. We provided juice, water and loaf cakes for the Cemetery mass in August. We made a donation to a hygiene project for third world countries and a donation to the Peterborough Warming Room.
