## **Purpose:**

To provide guidance to the membership and outline proper meeting procedures.

## **Procedure:**

- a) The captain or his/her designee will be in charge of the meeting. If the captain is absent the responsibility will fall to the lieutenants.
- b) Members shall arrive on time each week. Start time unless otherwise told is 1830 hours on the first and third Friday of every month. First meeting will be at Station 41, 180 4<sup>th</sup> Street, S. W. and the second meeting will be at the Largo training tower located at 751 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue S. E., unless other wise told by the cadet advisor.
- c) Cadets shall come prepared with all their gear, fully hydrated, and prepared for activity. Breaks will be given throughout the eventing. It is recommended that the cadet bring plenty of water and a light snack.
- d) Members are not to wear their bunker gear or uniform at any social event or party without permission from the post advisor. Members may stop for a meal at a restaurant, but must abide by the rules of conduct at all times.
