SUNSET VILLA AGM 2021

How will we execute the AGM this year?

Covid lock-downs have been a fact of life for a year now. The Ontario government has just announced some easing of Covid restrictions. However, things could change fairly quickly and we could wind back in another lock-down. The Covid variants are a potentially serious risk factor that we are unable to properly assess at this time.

At this time it is way too risky to consider holding an indoor AGM. We simply don't believe that holding an indoor meeting with fifty or so participants will be allowed in the foreseeable future. Instead the Sunset Villa Directors have decided to hold an online AGM as all other organizations are doing. Please reserve 2 p.m. on Sunday May 30th, 2021 on your calendars. It will be held by Zoom and instructions and materials will

be mailed to all active 2021

members.

Membership Renewals and AGM attendance: Holding an online AGM will require us to work in a new way. Directors have decided that no membership payments will take place on the day of the AGM. Eligibility to participate at the AGM will be based on you renewing your membership by May 21, 2021. If you plan on mailing your renewal notice in via Canada Post you will need to mail it by Friday May 7th to allow for postal delivery and membership processing. Should you choose to renew your membership via e-transfer or Visa/MC, your deadline will be Friday May 21st.

The AGM package will be sent by mail to all in May 2021, two weeks prior to the AGM for your review.




ALL BOARD POSITIONS ARE OPEN:

thank you from the Butik!

The Butik had record high gross sales of \$21,045 in 2020! After taxes and expenses, net profit was \$14,203.

This was very exciting for us, since there was no Constitution Day, only five baker days, and the Butik inside the restaurant was closed the whole year! To compare, net profit was \$8,203 in 2019, and \$8,362 in 2018.

So what changed to make this happen?!

We changed locations and operated out of a shed which increased visibility. We were open most weekends. We advertised Danish plates for sale online, learned to print tshirts, and sold 200 cookbooks.

We also accepted etransfers, credit cards & paypal, and offered shipping!

We want to thank you, our customers for generously supporting the Butik! And a big thank you also to everyone that created and donated things to sell!

And lastly, a **huge thank you to the special volunteers** that helped at the new outdoor Butik! We love you and you make it fun! It takes a Villa to keep Sunset going!



Any Danish plates or artwork given directly to the restaurant operators become their property, as it is an independent operation, and they decorate as they like. There is some donated artwork (pre-2018) in the restaurant that still belongs to Sunset Villa, and this is noted in the lease.
