Your Help Needed: Annual Parent/Fundraising Donation (and THANK YOU)

We hope you are enjoying the summer and the pre-season CHS football activities. Go Warriors! Here is some information regarding the Donation Fundraiser.

The role of Football Boosters (formerly QBC): We exist to support our players and CHS Football - usually seen in the form of food or equipment! Each season, Football Boosters provides:

- All players: a meal for every away game – subsidized by a local restaurant. We've been lucky to have Firehouse subs provide a full meal at a reasonable price for 2 years.
- All players attend Team Meals, held on the night before each home Varsity game.
- Helps to pay for your player to attend Senior Trip the summer before senior season.
- Trainers for summer camp (non-BVSD time). Extra food or water for 7 on 7s.
- Homecoming/community outreach

As many of you know, the above items are not possible without donations of time, items or money from our program families. And, to minimize outreach: One campaign – right here. As you speak with CHS families, you will learn that the cost for football is lower than most CHS sports.

2018 One-Time Donation Program

If at all possible, Boosters requests that all families look at making a donation based on the Tier 1 level, however we understand that this may not be possible based on individual family situations. Additionally, all knowledge of donation amounts will be kept within the elected QBC Board and not shared with coaches, parents or school faculty. While we cannot require your participation, we ask that you please think about what the program will provide your son, both on and off the field.

Tier 1: \$250, Donor receives: 2 t-shirts (Camp) and 2 box tix to game of choice, 1st come, 1st served.

Tier 2: \$150, Donor receives 2 t-shirts (Camp)

Tier 3: \$75, Donor receives 1 t-shirt (Camp)

Please donate by the **Blue White Scrimmage, August 25th** for use for the full season. If it's easier for you to make 2 or 3 smaller payments, that works great too. Use Revtrak at CHSwarriorfootball.com or make checks to "QBC" and give to Cynthia or Leslie.

We will still require (and greatly appreciate!) parent volunteers for activities. Also, the Warrior Card program will continue, as this is a fundraiser specifically for the team by the team and the coaching staff.
