ASH WEDNESDAY in 2021 at Holy Family & St Anne's

This is how we will distribute the Ashes: Father says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel", or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return". Father Jim/Aidan then cleanses their hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes by going to those who are standing in their places. The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them over the heads of the assembly without saying anything.

Mass will be said at Holy Family at 9am & 7pm; and St Anne's at 10.30am.

Order of Solemn Exposition: Cannot be held this year due to Covid-19. The Blessed Sacrament is exposed 3 times a week during private prayer at HF Freckleton. Please come along.

Tuesday 11am - 12 noon; Thursday 6pm - 7pm; and Saturday 10am - 11am.
