## **Be Prepared for National Zucchini Day!**

Here in the United States we love our national holidays. The gathering of family and friends for a shared meal, fun and games, as well as spirited conversation, is an American tradition. Now there is another holiday to add to your calendar - August 8th is National Zucchini Day! It is a day to honor this versatile vegetable and all the delicious dishes we can make with it. As a close relative of the cucumber and the melon, it is a type of squash that was introduced into this country by Italian immigrants in the 1920's. Since then, it has become a mainstay in kitchens of every ethnic background.

When purchasing your zucchini at the Willoughby Outdoor Market, they should be heavy for their size and firm to the touch. The darker the skin, the more nutrients they have. They can be stored in a plastic bag in the fridge and are best if used within two to three days. Zucchini can be prepared using a variety of cooking techniques, including steamed,

boiled, grilled, stuffed, baked, fried (and deep-fried) or incorporated into other recipes such as bread, frittata, muffins, ratatouille and minestrone. They can also be cut with a spiralizer to make "zoodles" that can act as a pasta substitute for low-carb recipes. Zucchini can be eaten raw when you slice or shred it into a salad.

A few fun facts about zucchini: 1. They are made up of 95% water. 2. One zucchini is actually called a zucchina. 3. One zucchina has only 25 calories. 4. Zucchini has more potassium than a banana. 5. The Guinness Book of World Records lists the largest known zucchina as over eight feet long and was grown in Niagara Falls, Ontario in 2014. If you want to get serious about celebrating zucchini, you can attend Zucchinifest in Obetz, Ohio (near Columbus) on September 3rd through September 6th and enjoy such festivities as the zucchini parade and the crowning of the "Zucchini Queen." You can wash down all those favorite fair foods with a special zucchini craft beer offered by BrewDog. Only in America!

The Willoughby Outdoor Market is brought to you by Heart of Willoughby ("HOW"), a non-profit group of volunteers with a mission of maintaining and improving the downtown Willoughby area since 1979. 



# Lakeland Distributes Another Round of Emergency Funding to Students

Community Lakeland College will distribute another round of emergency grants to eligible students. As of July 7, 2021, over \$2.8 million has already been given directly to Lakeland students to help defray costs associated with college.

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) that provides COVID-19 relief to students under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act and the American Rescue

The funding comes via the Plan. Students may use the grant toward the cost of attendance, or for emergency costs that they've incurred due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, medical and mental health care, technology or child care.

The grants are available to all enrolled students (excluding College Credit Plus). Students do not need to be a financial recipient to receive aid assistance but are encouraged to complete the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to determine eligibility additional for federal, state and local funding opportunities.

Lakeland first distributed emergency grant funds in May 2020 through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act specifically intended to provide emergency financial aid grants to students. Many who rely on campus resources such as computer labs, Wi-Fi, food pantry, child care, etc., unexpectedly had additional costs in order to continue the semester entirely online.


