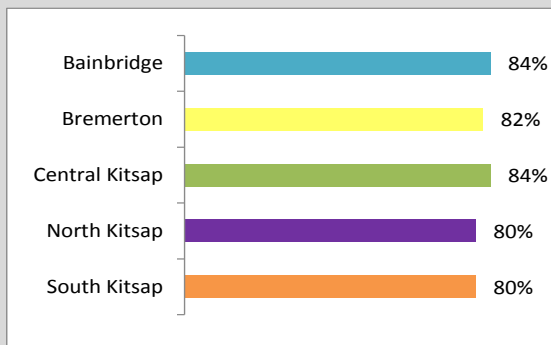

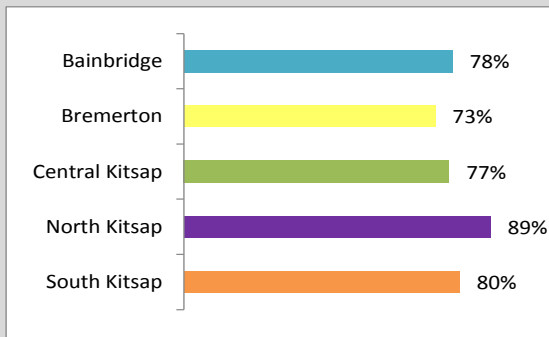

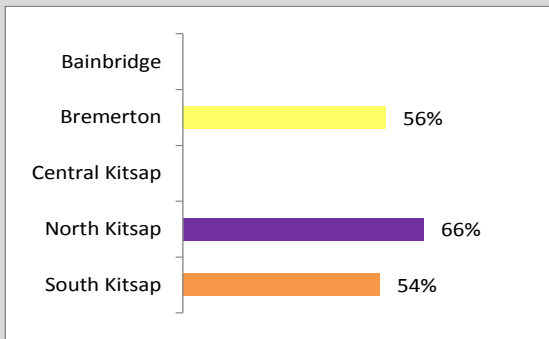

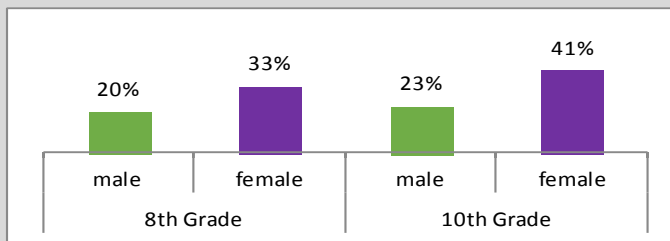

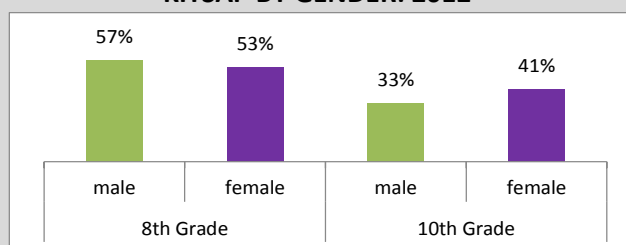

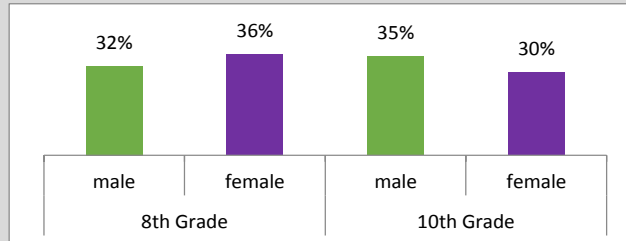

**F.1.13. YOUTH HAVE ADULT TO TURN TO WHEN FEELING SAD OR HOPELESS**

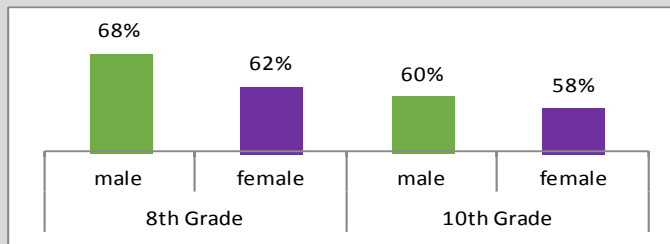

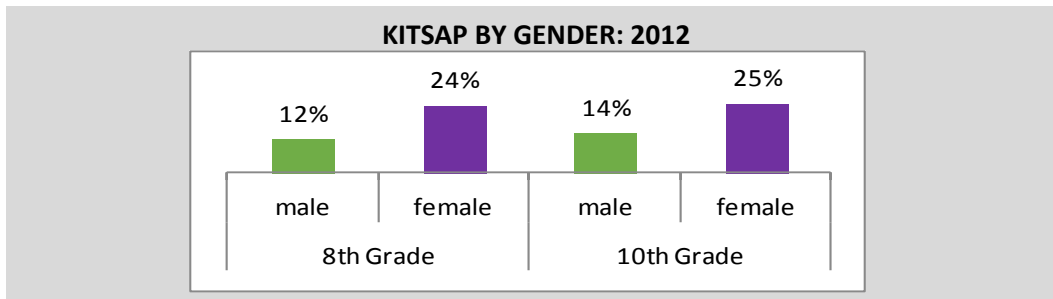

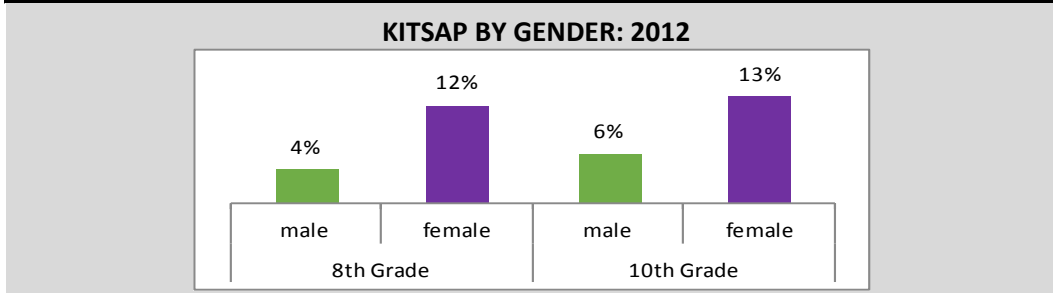

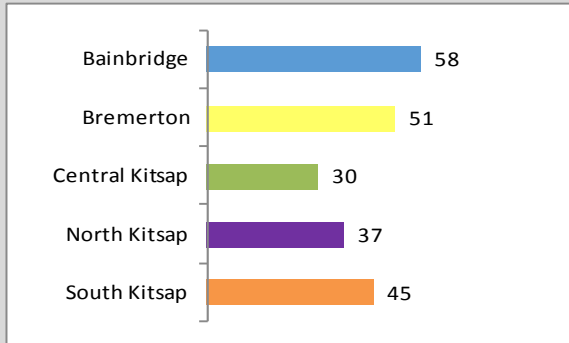

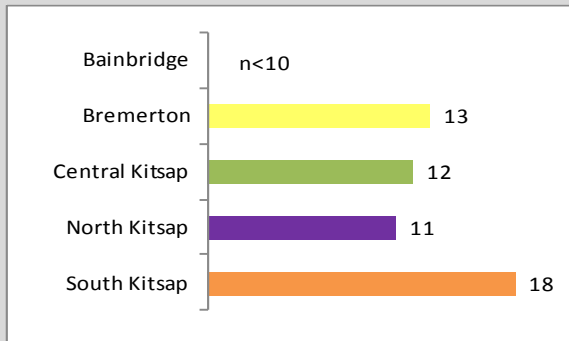

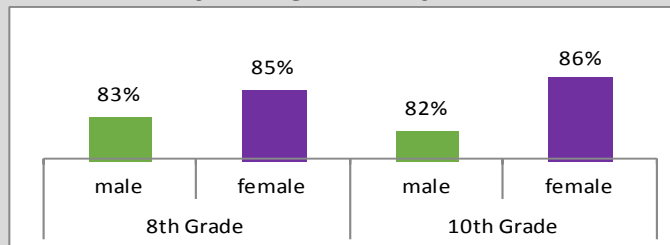

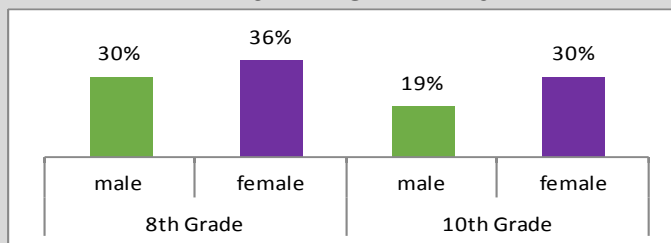

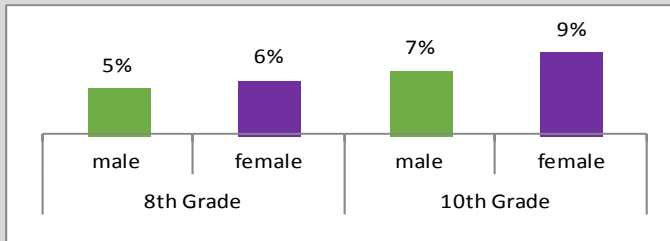

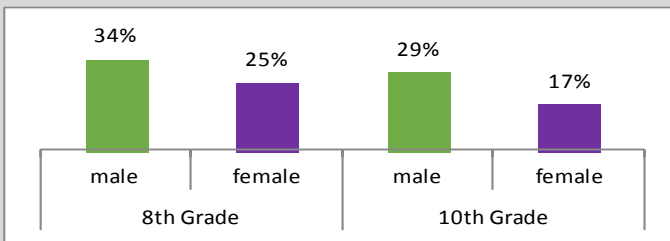

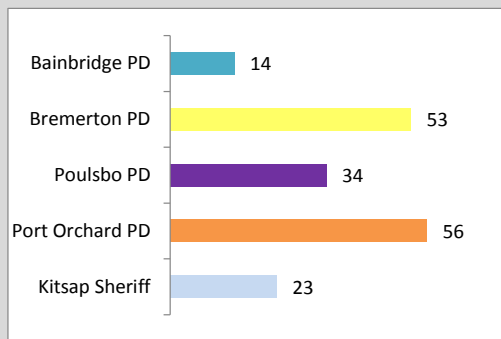

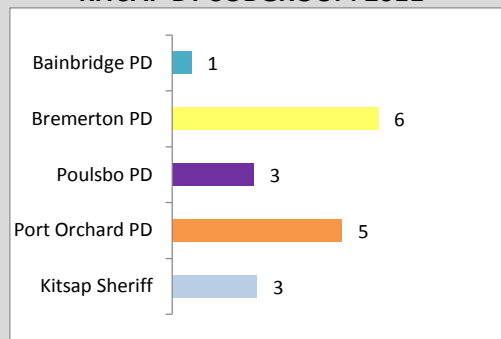

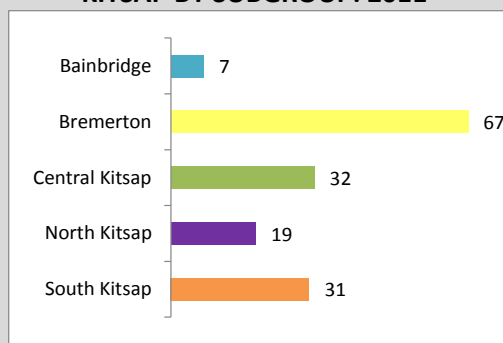

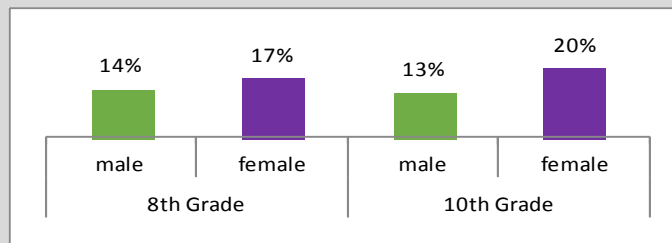


**F.2.9. YOUTH HAVE EVER BEEN PHYSICALLY ABUSED BY AN ADULT**
