Stall Boarding - Full Care

Includes:

- Exclusive use of and access to one stall per horse
- Use and access to all "active" pastures
- Use of all arenas, trails, training ring and all common areas
- Use of Tack Locker
- SFF personnel will:
 - Turn out & bring in horse according to seasonal schedule
 - Muck stalls daily & replace bedding
 - Provide hay and ample water to each horse
 - Upon request, Feed supplements to horses (owner provided)
 - Put on/take off blankets, sheets, fly masks, and apply fly spray





Stall Boarding – Partial Care

Includes:

- Exclusive use of and access to one stall per horse
- Use and access to all "active" pastures
- Use of all arenas, trails, training ring and all common areas
- ✤ SFF personnel will:
 - Turn out & bring in horse according to seasonal schedule
 - During turn-out, provide water and free choice hay (as needed, during nongrazing season)
- Owner is responsible for:
 - Mucking stalls & replacing bedding daily
 - Daily feeding/watering
- Owner may use SFF hay & bedding
- Tack Lockers available for monthly rental





Field Boarding

(Horses in pasture 24/7 with run-in shelters)

Includes:

- Use of all arenas, trails, training ring & outdoor tack areas
- Tack Lockers available for monthly rental
- SFF personnel will:
 - Visually check horse daily for signs of injury/illness
 - Rotate field boarded horses according to field rotation schedule
 - ✤ Provide ample water
 - Provide hay during nongrazing season
