He gave a Covid update, letting us know that at this time there is no indication of a state of emergency being implemented. The courthouse remains open with regular hours. The Mid-Michigan Health Department continues to monitor Covid numbers regularly. The 911 changeover is moving along as planned with area emergency services transitioning to the statewide radio system. The Broadband update was presented & the baseline study is underway.
