Treasury Report: \$1566.70

Brian has \$1613.02 to hand in = \$3179.72. Slate Billiards still owes dues from last season. All other dues from last season are paid. Spent funds: 1311.90 on trophies, \$400 banquet blind draw, \$400 gift cards, \$1.20 for postage for tourney results, \$70.88 for ink and paper, \$250 for statistician fee for the past season. Motioned by Dave Phillips to accept with a 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jackie Pavone.

**Old Business:**

- The board will discuss the next banquet day/date at the next meeting.
- Plaques- John Lafreniere suggested for plaque next banquet. Other suggestions Justin Jones, Josh Davenport and AaronCampbell. The board will further discuss at the end of next season.
- Chris has not been able to stop by heroes.
- Ink Link tattoo/bar has 2 of the new dart boards. Brian needs an invoice for \$80. There will most likely be 2 teams out of this bar.
- Brian did not stop by any of the bars to follow up. Dave stopped by 1 for the road, very interested. Brian may have been able to get a team from foster's too.
- Winter fling- profit \$849. Break down: entry fees: \$2531.00, 50/50: \$346.00, Liquor raffle: \$190.00, Total: \$3067.00. Chris thinks in the future, the league should purchase some prizes to add to the liquor table in order to increase participation.
- Palm Beacher- 4/2/16. The State team will be there to run the tournament. Steve L will run the boards. Brian will run the check-in table. Board members are not required to be present.
- Conflict with Ron hill is resolved. The red parrot will be limited to 1 team per night next season.
- Rule revisions- proposed from Rules change committee. Page 3: double in should include the double bull. Page 7- rounds of 5 for men should be added. Brian states this has already been corrected. Page 8- When dues are paid. This has already been updated. Bi-laws- include a copy of the seal.
- Forfeits- When a team forfeits the opposing team will no longer receive a full night's points. An average of the teams winning points will be awarded. The average will be determined from the points won during the current cycle of play. A cycle is complete after all teams have played one another. For example: if there are 4 teams then there would be a 3 week cycle.
- Postponements- A postponement may take place if both team captains agree to a postponement. The game will be played at the original bar. A board member must be notified prior to play. The match will be completed in the time frame that falls after the preceding

scheduled night and before the following scheduled night of play. Which leave a 13 day window of time to complete the match.

- End of season ties- There will be an option to play a playoff match if both captains agree. All star points will not be awarded. Venue decision will be agreed upon by captains, if no agreement can be reached then a coin toss will be utilized. The playoff match will be completed within 1 week of completion of regular season play.
