The Holy Spirit works upon us: "When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment." John 16:8 The Holy Spirit lives within us: "Don't you know that you yourselves are God's temple and that God's Spirit lives in you?" 1 Corinthians 3:16 The Holy Spirit points us to Jesus Christ: "...the Spirit of truth... will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you." John 16:13,14 The forgoing scriptures only present a fundamental understanding of the Holy Spirit, not a complete view of His presence among us and within us. What have you heard about the Holy Spirit in classes, on television or from the pulpit? Perhaps the following points will help you wade through some ideas about the Spirit and appreciate His presence even more: 1. The Holy Spirit is not just karma or 'the life force'. The scriptures describe the Holy Spirit as a personal identity. 2. The work of the Holy Spirit did not end with the apostles or with those upon whom the apostles laid their hands. Miracles confirmed apostolic authority but the Holy Spirit continues His work in other ways today. 3. The Holy Spirit does not come and go like the blowing wind, even though the linguistic root of wind and spirit is similar. He is constantly with you as long as He is welcome, even if you don't feel His presence at the moment. 4 The Holy Spirit is not an 'optional extra' for believers in Jesus. He is the seal of God's approval upon all Christians. We have a commitment, empowered by the Holy Spirit, To give glory to God To be unified in reaching others To be living witnesses for Christ

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6,7
