Dear Residents,

Dr. Hamilton and I are proud to report to you that progress has been made with our recently proposed legislation to Senator Greenstein.

Senator Linda Greenstein has introduced our proposed legislation to the Senate which is now known as S2307. This proposed legislation would provide the relief in the form of additional State Aid by eliminating the State Aid Growth Limit for school districts that are in Municipalities that have a population comprised of greater than one-third senior citizens age 65 years or older according to the most recent federal decennial census. This would increase future State Aid awards by approximately 6.9 million dollars based on the 2012/2013 State Aid data and would directly reduce your local tax levy.
