### **CHAPERONES:**

There are 10 band/strings parents, Mr. Blankenship and a DSF administrator who will be accompanying the students to Orlando. All HCPS policies in terms of behavior and conduct will be strictly enforced during the entire trip.

## **ITINERARY:**

The itinerary for the trip is attached. Please note the following:

1. Report time for students is 7:00 pm on Wednesday April 11. Students will check-in with their chaperones in the big gym.

2. Cars cannot be left in the student lot so all students must be dropped off.

3. Please have student medications in a labeled Ziploc bag and have your student give that bag to his/her chaperone when they check-in. Make sure the medications match the information on the student form.

4. Students will be accompanied by chaperones for the entire trip. While in the Disney parks, students will be free to enjoy the parks on their own and check in periodically with their chaperones. Students will not be permitted to "park hop" – once in each park they will stay in that park until the entire group departs. Roll call is done at each bus departure. Chaperones will use cell phones to communicate with students.

5. Chaperones will be housed on the same floors as the students and "lights out" will be strictly enforced.
