GENERAL INFORMATION AND FAQS

Garbage Collection:

The Town provides weekly garbage collection service and bi-weekly recycle collection service for all Town Residents using Republic Services. Republic is only required to pick up one (1) 96-gallon trash cart and/or one (1) 65-gallon recycle cart per week. Please have all carts at the roadside curb by 6:30am on Monday mornings. This service is for normal household garbage and recycle only (recycle pick-up is every other Monday). Please contact Republic at (336) 299-0815 for a special pick-up of bulk items

Animal Shelter:

Animal Control Protection Services - The Town provides this service for all Town Residents through the Guilford County Department of Animal Control. If you have a problem with stray or injured animals, please call GC Animal Control at (336) 641-5990 or the GC Sheriff's Department.

Town Hall Grounds Use:

The Town Hall grounds have been made available for special events such as yard sales. A completed request form along with a \$50 deposit is required at least five (5) days prior to the event. This form must be signed by a Town Official/Town Clerk. Official meetings of the Town government and its boards have first priority over other activities. The deposit will be returned only if no damage is done to the property.

If you are or know of someone new moving into the Sedalia area, please contact the Town Hall Office so our records can be updated, and individuals can receive information such as the Town Meeting Schedule, and also be signed up for the garbage & recycle service.
