107.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of this chapter is to provide regulations regarding the use of the City yard waste site and the City burn site and to identify materials that are acceptable and unacceptable for deposit at either site.

107.02 ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS.

1. Yard Waste Site. The following materials may be deposited at the City yard waste site:

- A. Leaves
- B. Grass clippings
- C. Garden waste

2. Burn Site. The following materials may be deposited at the City burn site:

- A. Trees and tree trimmings
- B. Bushes and bush trimmings

107.03 PROHIBITED MATERIALS. It is unlawful for any person to place or deposit or permit to be placed or deposited at the City yard waste site or at the City burn site any materials other than those specifically authorized for the respective sites under Section 107.02 of this chapter. Materials prohibited at both sites include (but are not limited to) tires, batteries, appliances, wire, boards, lumber, construction waste, metal, glass, plastic, plastic bags, paper, paper bags, food and food products, garbage, and any other natural or processed materials not specifically identified in Section 107.02.

107.04 HOURS. It is unlawful for any person to deposit materials at the City yard waste site or City burn site other than during the hours when the sites are open to the public pursuant to City Council resolution. The City Superintendent shall have authority to schedule special appointments for depositing materials during hours when the sites are otherwise closed.

107.05 FIRES. No fires shall be lit at the City yard waste site, and only the City Superintendent shall be authorized to light fires at the City burn site. It is unlawful for any other person to set or cause to be set any fire at either site.

107.06 RULES. The City Superintendent shall have the power to make such additional rules and regulations pertaining to use of the City yard waste site and City burn site as do not conflict with this chapter.
