The Parish School of Religion Needs Your Help!

Our Parish School of Religion covers both Sacred Heart and St. Joseph parishes and this upcoming year will be a big year of transition. Deacon Steve Vogt will remain the teacher for High School students, but we need teachers for grades 1through 8. In addition, the directors of our PSR program- Sarah Paynter and Rebekah Weber would like to step down after several years of dedicated service.

We need teachers for our students, so we need members of the parish to step up and pass on the Catholic faith. Grade 2 and Junior High are of particular importance this year because these students need to be prepared for the sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation. I want to encourage new people to consider becoming PSR teachers because if the same people are always volunteering for parish ministries there is a possibility of them overextending themselves and becoming burnt out. None of us wants that.

A PSR teacher needs to be a Catholic in good standing which includes, but is not limited to:

Attends Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation Is not divorced and remarried without an annulment Follows and practices Catholic Doctrine

PSR is scheduled to begin in September (High School in October) on Wednesday nights from 7:00-8:00 p.m. Please consider this important ministry of passing on the faith to our kids. You will receive teaching aids to help you make the faith exciting for the students. If we do not have enough volunteers for PSR then we may have to shut it down and have to direct the children to the Galion or Shelby PSR classes. I do not want that to have to happen. All you potential teachers can prevent that by praying about it and stepping up and spreading the beautiful truth of our faith to our youth. The grace of God can help us do amazing things!
