PRAY – Pray for Scoops and Scripture and the lives that are impacted by the Gospel. Pray for the communities we will be working in to share the good news of Jesus Christ. Pray for God to begin to open the hearts of individuals to hear and respond to the Gospel. Pray that God receives ALL of the honor and glory that He deserves through this ministry!

PREPARE – Make sure that you read this manual so that you will be best prepared to serve in this ministry. You will need to initially prepare by completing your volunteer application and background check. Then, you will have ongoing preparation as you get ready for each meeting at your facility. It is important to be prepared for each meeting, to have a good example and witness among the facilities. However, it is most important that your heart is prepared before the Lord by daily walking in relationship with Him so that your ministry is an overflow of your intimacy with Jesus Christ.

PROMOTE – Recruit other people to help you serve at your facility. Talk about Scoops and Scripture in your churches and your fellow communities of believers. Encourage others to join you at your facility. Pray and consider whether the Lord is asking you to open a new facility.

It is our prayer that God would be glorified throughout the entire ministry and that His name would be made known. We are so excited that the Lord has led you to serve within your community in this way. We will be praying for you as you step out in faith and walk into local facilities with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

ABOUT SCOOPS & SCRIPTURE

Welcome to Scoops and Scripture! Scoops and Scripture is a Christ-centered organization, dedicated to service. How? By serving God's love and Gospel one scoop of ice cream at a time! Many Christians have the desire to share the Gospel in their community, yet find it difficult to discover where to serve and how to get started. We endeavor to offer an easy to follow outline and "program in a box" that provides anyone who wants to serve the opportunity. That way you can spend your time actually serving instead of working on the logistics and details of preparing to serve.

Scoops and Scripture seeks to go into residential facilities and provide the residents who live there with a Gospel centered, fun-filled time to come together and fellowship. We spend time with people; God's people. Whether it's serving in retirement homes, children's homes, homes for people in crisis, and more, Scoops is a framework for building relationships and sharing God's love with others. We love the Lord and we love others. No two commandments could be a better goal!

A typical Scoops and Scripture experience would be led by a volunteer team on a monthly basis at a local facility. When the Scoops team visits each month, they would engage the residents by singing a few songs, sharing a Bible-based devotional including a personal Scripture memory card, handing out a few door prizes, taking pictures with each resident, and ending with an ice cream party together! Each resident also receives a photo album to store their Scripture memory cards and photos of each gathering with their Scoops friends. This allows the Gospel to be shared not only through the devotionals, but through building relationships and sharing our lives as well.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:

Scoops and Scripture is a local nonprofit ministry that partners with the local church to mobilize believers to engage people with the gospel in local residential facilities. Each Scoops volunteer teams visit their assigned residential facility monthly for a time of singing, gospel devotional, door prizes, photos, fellowship and an ice cream party. Every resident who attends receives a photo album and each month gets a new Scripture card and printed photo with their Scoops team to keep. This is a way for us to show them that we care about their relationship with God but also about our relationship with them. At the heart of Scoops we are looking to love residents in these facilities so much that we are "*delighted to share not only the Gospel of Jesus Christ, but our lives as well*" (1 Thess. 2:18).

- Biweekly or monthly visit from Scoops team at a designated facility
- Deliver prepared Bible-based message (usually approx 15 minutes)
- Prepare scripture cards with a verse from the message to put in their Scoops albums
- Time of worship (usually 2-3 hymns)
- Picture taking with residents and Scoops team
- Ice cream party
- Prayer and prayer requests
- LOTS of hugs

WHO AND WHERE

Scoops and Scripture is God sent and is a great activity for the entire family, bible study group, or anyone that feels led to serve as they share the gospel and the love of Christ with those in our communities. Scoops can be tweaked to accommodate any venue...nursing homes, children's homes, adult day care centers, veteran's homes, halfway or rehabilitation homes...the sky is the limit! WHY SCOOPS AND SCRIPTURE?

There are many opportunities that you have to share the Gospel with your community. So why did the Lord lead us to start this specific ministry? There are many reasons that we feel that Scoops and Scripture can be just the right thing for you or your small group to use as a bridge into our community.

1. It gives structure to local ministry outside the walls of the church with a focus to engage the residents in a way that connects them to your local church. *Scoops and Scripture primarily goes to residential facilities, where the people at those local facilities may or may not be able to get out and attend churches locally. However, we would encourage you to promote your local church in the facilities and build a Gospel centered partnership between this local facility and your local church.*
2. It is an established program and organization that may help allow you access into your local residential facilities. *For example, if you have a local facility where you would like to serve, rather than calling and just mentioning that you would like to volunteer at their facility, you can ask them for this specific program to be implemented through your volunteers. They may be more likely to allow a structured program to come to their facility. They would be able to visit our website and see examples of other facilities, etc.*
3. The framework for the ministry can be adapted to the demographic of the residents in the facilities as well as the demographic of the volunteers in your group. *For example, if you have children wanting to participate with their families, you could meet on a Saturday morning at a nursing home and allow the children to help serve the ice cream. Or, if you had a women's Bible study group of mostly retired women or stay at home moms, you could meet during the week mornings at a local home for women in crisis. Or, if you have a community group already meeting on a weekly basis in the evenings, you could simply meet once a month at a local facility and serve in the place of regular community group Bible study. The possibilities are endless!*
4. Everyone has a place to serve every month with their own strengths and gifts. *Every month, volunteers are needed to help lead the music and lead the devotion, but besides these two jobs, volunteers are also needed to make the scripture cards, purchase the ice cream, organize the door prizes, take pictures, print pictures, visit with the residents, offer smiles and hugs and more! No matter what you feel like your gifts are or are not, there is a need and a place for you to serve within this ministry!*

Background Check Information

To protect our volunteers and also the residents in our facilities, we do require that all of our Scoops and Scripture volunteers complete a background check through an independent organization: *Protect My Ministry*. All applicants are responsible to pay for their background check personally. Depending on the state in which you live, the price of your background check will vary from nine dollars to seventeen dollars.

Note: Scoops and Scripture does not set the price or the specific type of background check that you must complete, but complies with the recommendations set forth by our insurance company and Protect My Ministry company. Also, we do have scholarships available for volunteers who would be prevented from serving for financial reasons. Please contact our main office for more details.

Confidentiality Statement

Due to the nature of our organization, it is with utmost importance that we respect the ones we encounter and their right to privacy. It is imperative that we keep all information regarding the lives we touch to ourselves. This includes, but not limited to, each one's prayer requests, names, locations and anything else you may learn of while visiting. It is our prayer to protect and respect one's privacy and keep everyone safe.

Facility Partner Statement

It is the responsibility of every volunteer to be aware of all policies and procedures in place by the facility in which they choose to serve through Scoops and Scripture. Please ask your Scoops Facility Coordinator or your facility Activities Coordinator if you have any questions. This would include, but is not limited to, policies including taking photos of residents, use of social media, helping residents around the facility, food and dietary restrictions, personal gifts, handing out door prizes and any other policies that your facility may have of which you need to be aware. We want to make sure that our facilities trust our volunteers as we show the utmost respect to the employees and residents at each facility.

Scoops and Scripture - Statement of Faith

We believe that the Bible is the written Word of God, inspired by the Holy Spirit and without error in the original manuscripts, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. The Bible is the revelation of God's truth and is infallible and authoritative in all matters of faith and practice. (*2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21; Mark 13:31; John 8:31-32; John 20:31; Acts 20:32*)

We believe in the Holy Trinity. There is one God – Creator, Sustainer, and Ruler of all things – infinite and unchanging, who exists eternally in three persons; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. These persons are equal in every divine way, and they execute distinct but harmonious offices in the work of creation, providence and redemption. (*Genesis 1:1, 26; Deuteronomy 6:4; John 1:1, 3; Matthew 28:19; John 4:24; Romans 1:19-20; Ephesians 4:5-6*)

We believe in God the Father, infinite in perfect holiness, wisdom, power and love. God is all powerful and all knowing; and His perfect knowledge extends to all things, past, present, and future. We believe that God the Father reigns with providential care over His universe, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves from sin and death all who come to Him through Jesus Christ. (*Exodus 15:11-27; Luke 10:21,22; Matthew 23:9; John 3:16; 6:27; Romans 1:7; Romans 8:14-15; I Timothy 1:1,2; 2:5,6; I Peter 1:3; Revelation 1:6*)

We believe in the eternal deity of our Lord Jesus Christ – the Son of God, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious, atoning death for the sins of all who would trust in Him alone for salvation through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. (*Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-38; John 1:1; 20:28; Romans 9:5; 8:46; II Corinthians 5:21; I Peter 2:21-23; John 20:30, 31; Matthew 20:28; Ephesians 1:4; Acts 1:11; Romans 5:6-8; 6:9,10; Hebrews 7:25; Hebrews 9:28; I Timothy 3:16*)

We believe in the Holy Spirit who came forth from the Father and Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify and empower all who believe in Jesus Christ. We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells God's people and enables them to trust Christ in faith and follow Him in repentance and godly living; (*John 14:16,17,26; 15:26,27; John 16:9-14; Romans 8:9; I Corinthians 3:16; 6:19; Galatians 5:22-26*)

We believe that man was created by God in His own image; that through the temptation of Satan, Adam transgressed the command of God and thereby incurred physical, spiritual and eternal death, which is separation from God, and inherited a nature corrupt and wholly opposed to God and His law. Therefore, all people since Adam and Eve are sinners by nature and are sinners by choice, guilty in God's sight, under condemnation and are totally unable to save themselves from God's righteous wrath. His grace alone provides a way of salvation. (*Genesis. 1:26; 5:2; Genesis 3; Genesis 2:17; 3:19; Psalm 51:7; Proverbs 28:13; Eccl. 2:11; Jeremiah 17:9; John 1:13, 3:14-16; 5:24; John 5:30; 7:13; 8:12; 10:26; Romans 3:19, 5:19, 8:1, 9:22; II Corinthians 5:17; II Thessalonians 1:9; James 1:14; I John 1:9; Rev. 19:3,20; 20:10,14,15; 21:18;*)

We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful people, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential, and is administered solely by the grace of God through our faith in Jesus Christ. Repentance is a genuine turning from sin towards God. Faith is the acceptance of Jesus Christ and commitment of the entire person to Him as Lord and Savior. This is the gospel, that by grace through faith in Jesus, sinners repent and are forgiven by God and declared righteous in His sight. The purpose of the Christian life is to glorify God and enjoy Him in gratitude. (*Acts 2:37-38; Romans 3:23-28; 4:1-5, 5:8-10, 10:14; I Corinthians 6:20; 2 Corinthians 7:10-11; Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 2:1-8; Philippians 1:29; Titus 3:5; James 2:14-26; 1 John 5:1*)

We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ to earth and the establishment of His kingdom. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; those who are saved into everlasting life in the presence of Christ, and those who are lost into everlasting condemnation and separation from Him. (*Matthew 16:27; Mark 14:62; John 14:3; Acts 1:11; Phil. 3:20; I Thessalonians 4:15; II Timothy 4:1; Titus 2:13; I Corinthians 4:5; I Corinthians 15; II Thessalonians 1:7-10; Revelation 20:4-6,11-15*)

The Gospel

The Primary purpose of Scoops and Scripture ministry is to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ, by sharing our lives with the people we encounter. Service void of the Gospel is nothing more than humanitarian community work. Therefore, we must share the Gospel with those we serve. Scoops and Scripture is not focused on the number of “decisions” we can attain at a location. Rather, we are passionate about volunteers knowing and sharing the Gospel in a Biblical way. We trust in the Holy Spirit to save people. Our job is merely to proclaim the Good News. Scoops and Scripture provides participants with opportunities to hear the Word of God taught in a familiar setting. INTERESTED IN SERVING AS A VOLUNTEER

The beauty of the Scoops and Scripture ministry is twofold...its intentional message and its simplicity. First and foremost, Scoops and Scripture's motivation is Jesus Christ. Prompted by love in the Spirit, we are committed to sharing the Good News of salvation and advancing God's Kingdom. Second, we are excited to provide a fun, simple, pre-prepared program for Christians with a desire to do "something". We've found that so many people truly want to serve, but really don't know how to get started. Scoops and Scripture is formulated perfectly for those individuals. For those who like to lead, they can facilitate their own Scoops chapter at a location of their choice (*see next page for information on becoming a facilitator*).

Volunteer Responsibilities

1. Complete volunteer application packet (*found in manual*) and background check.
2. Attend regular Scoops and Scripture meetings at your facility.
3. Complete assigned tasks by your facility leader (*examples may include: purchasing ice cream, leading the devotion, leading singing, purchasing door prizes, making Scripture cards, etc.*)

1. PRAY and ask the Lord where He may desire you to serve with Scoops and Scripture. Consider your schedule, your passion and the people the Lord may be asking you to share you life and the gospel of Jesus Christ with every month.

2. COMPLETE a volunteer application and background check. Background checks are run through an independent organization, *Protect My Ministry*. 4. SERVE with the ministry as you love so much that you delight to share with others not only the gospel of God but your lives as well (I Thess. 2:8).

INTERESTED IN SERVING AS A FACILITY LEADER

Facility Leader Responsibilities

1. Complete volunteer application and background check.
2. Once approved through Scoops and Scriptures as a facility leader, contact a local facility through their Activities Coordinator and plan a day and time to serve.
3. Organize and plan each Scoops and Scripture meeting. This includes (but may not be limited to):
 - Purchasing ice cream, bowls and spoons
 - Planning the devotion
 - Planning some hymns
 - Purchasing door prizes
 - Making Scripture cards (or bringing supplies for participants to make their own depending on your facility).
4. Send a quarterly email to the main Scoops and Scripture office (thescoop@scoopsandscripture.org) with updates on your facility.

1. PRAY and ask the Lord where He may desire you to serve with Scoops and Scripture. Consider your schedule, your passion and the people the Lord may be asking you to share you life and the gospel of Jesus Christ with every month.

2. COMPLETE a volunteer application and background check. Background checks are run through an independent organization, *Protect My Ministry*. Volunteer applications and background checks are recorded every Tuesday through our main Scoops and Scripture office for official approval to begin serving. *Note: All volunteers are responsible to pay for their own background check. 3. CONFIRM with the main Scoops and Scripture office that you have been approved as a volunteer. We will send an email to both you and your facility coordinator letting you know as soon as we have processed your application and background check. As soon as you receive this email from the main office, you can begin to serve and attend Scoops and Scripture.

4. CONTACT a local facility through their activity coordinator. Plan a set date and time to meet with the activity coordinator and tour the facility. Set up day and time to host your Scoops and Scripture meetings. (*Note: for help on initiating a relationship with a facility, reference the Facility Leader Manual*).

5. SEND in your facility information form (*located on the website and in the Facility Leader Manual*) to the main Scoops and Scripture office via mail or email. Also, **SEND** in your quarterly update report to the main office via email (*located on the website and in the Facility Leader Manual*).

6. SERVE with the ministry as you love others so much that you delight to share not only the gospel of God but your lives as well (I Thess. 2:8).
