Welcome to our Summer Session



Drop off and pick up routines:

The main entrance to the Church parking lot is located on North Brewster Lane, please use that entrance ONLY.

The doors to the school will open at 8:45 a.m. for our early drop off students. The doors will reopen at 9:10 a.m. and classes start promptly at 9:15 a.m. The doors will open again at 11:40 a.m. for pick up. Let's all be considerate of each other and arrive promptly.

The teachers will be at their classroom doors to greet you with a sign in sheet. It is very important that everyone signs their child in and out of school each day.

Once classes are in session, the inside double doors are locked. Anyone wishing to enter the school must ring the buzzer located to the right of the double doors. No child will be released to anyone other than a parent, guardian, or authorized pick up person.



Dress

Your child will be working with paints, markers, glue and other messy substances when creating projects at the school. Play clothes that are suitable for getting dirty are best for wear at the school. **Please provide a full change of clothes labeled with your child's name, packed in a Ziploc bag to be kept in your child's backpack in case of an emergency.**

Sneakers are best for wear at the school. **Clogs, flip flops and sandals** can be hazardous during outdoor/big room play and **should not be worn to school.**

Weather permitting; we will go outside to play each day. Please apply sun block **BEFORE** your child comes to school.

Please provide the diapers and wipes for your child. If your child is being potty trained, we will help your child accomplish this task. Accidents do happen, so please, provide extra clothing, including underwear and socks.



Supplies

Please send a box of tissues and one package of wipes to clean the hands and faces of the children before and after snack. Any supplies received are greatly appreciated.

A backpack and lunchbox are necessary for transporting projects and snacks to and from school.



Snacks

There will be one snack time each day. Please send in your own snack and drink for your child each day. Healthy snacks and drinks should be sent. No soda, candy or chips!

Illness

If your child is exhibiting symptoms of any type of illness, please do not send him/her to school. Children with fevers can only return to school if they have been fever free for 24 hours without a fever reducer. Please bring to your child's teacher's attention any skin conditions or allergies that mimic viruses or cold like symptoms.
