

COVID-19 Breastfeeding Resource Kit

Benefits of breastfeeding during a pandemic:

- Breastfeeding is good for babies. It <u>protects</u> them from many infections. While it is still not clear if this
 is true for the COVID-19 virus, breastfed infants are generally less likely to have severe respiratory
 symptoms when they get sick.
- **Breastfeeding is good for moms.** Hormones released in the mother's body during breastfeeding promote wellness and can relieve stress and anxiety.
- Breast milk is readily available. No purchase necessary!
