### WEDNESDAY JUNE 21 AT WILLOW OAKS COUNTRY CLUB

Richmond Marine Terminal (RMT), formerly known as the Port of Richmond, is one of six terminals that comprise the Port of Virginia.

Ships quietly enter and leave the Richmond Marine Terminal on a daily basis and most of our residents have to be reminded occasionally that Richmond, VA has its own port. RMT, known as Deepwater Terminal, is visible from I-95, yet it goes largely unnoticed.

In the 1960's, the Port of Richmond was known primarily as a livestock port. Cattle and hog pens (and their distinctive odors) were vast on the grounds of the port. In 2023, the livestock is gone, replaced with ocean containers, breakbulk freight, and barges from Hampton Roads.

The Richmond Marine Terminal has the distinction of being a Teamsters Union port, instead of the International Longshoremen's Association, which has allowed it to remain active (and
