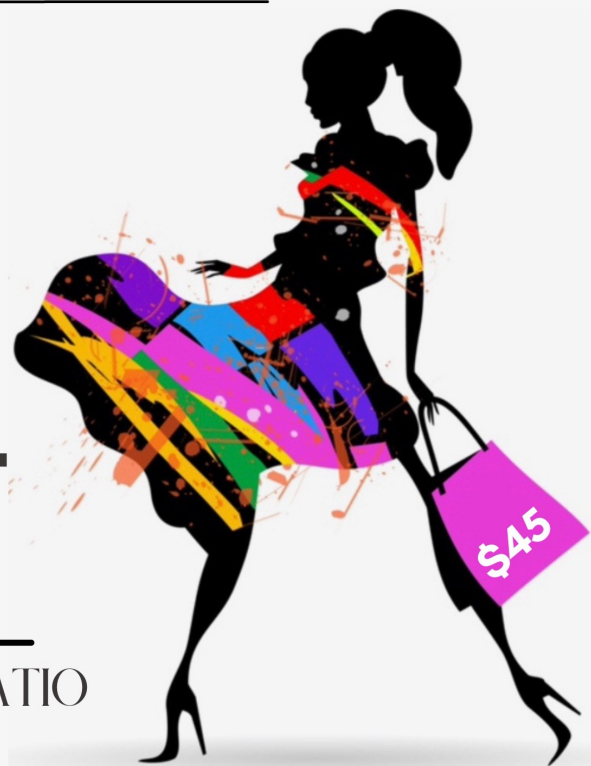

PRECINCT CAPTAIN — Waskah Whelan

Pay Attention: Sacramento is after the taxpayers . . . again. Sacramento's latest attack on Prop 13 and on the taxpayers is coming to everyone on the 2024 CA March Ballot.

The ACA 13 initiative will sharply lower Proposition 13's two-thirds voter threshold to 55%, so that Sacramento politicians can easily fund massive new tax hikes.

The Democrats want ACA 13 on the ballot to prevent the Carl DeMaio-Reform CA sponsored initiative: **The Taxpayer Protection and Government Accountability Act** from passing.

This popular act would restore all the Prop 13 protections the courts and Sacramento Democrats have eroded. It will be on the ballot in November 2024.

Under ACA 13, **legislative** backed constitutional amendments would still pass with a simple majority, but any **citizens' initiative constitutional amendments would require a two-thirds vote to pass!**

Look who your friends are: **The League of California Cities** is backing ACA 13, along with a coalition of **local government, teachers, labor unions, and nonprofit organizations**. These people are not the friends of the working public or the taxpayers. They want your money and they want to take away your power. Without money, you have no power.

In 1978, homeowners were losing their homes because of high property taxes . . . As much as 5% of purchase price in some areas. Can you afford that level of taxes? Go to **GuessingGame.ORG** online and check out what your new property taxes will be without Prop 13 protections. **You Better Be Sitting Down!**

Pass the Word . . . to renters, small business owners, and homeowners. We will all be in big trouble without Prop 13 to protect us. We don't yet know the title of the initiative the Democrats will put on the March ballot to kill off Prop 13. We do know it won't say that. It will talk about saving roads, schools, puppies, etc.
