



Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District is the proud recipient of an initial SMUD Shine award for the Arcade Creek Park “SPARKLE” Improvement Project.

The Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District has been notified that the “SPARKLE” Improvement Project at Arcade Creek Park has been awarded a SMUD Shine community-sponsorship award. The District is one of 21 recipients out of more than 100 applications. “Sparkle” is an estimated \$25,000 project that will provide additional lighting for the Arcade Creek Park located at 6513 Omni Drive in Sacramento County, CA 95841. The SMUD Shine award is for \$12,500.00 and requires a local funds match of \$12,500.00.

The Sacramento Parks Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose members include Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District, Arden Manor Recreation and Park District, Fulton-El Camino Recreation and Park District and Mission Oaks Recreation Park District. The Foundation received the grant award on behalf of the Arcade Creek Recreation and Park District. Each of the individual park districts use the Foundation as a repository for contributions and grants received outside of taxpayer dollars and other general fund revenue.

As mentioned on the included SMUD Press Release dated December 14, 2017, this project demonstrates collaboration, partnerships, and the potential for a broad community impact.
