As you are aware, the Town is attempting to ascertain the legal status of the Maietta Gravel Pit. I was advised today that a quarrying operation was commenced by your client sometime after it sent the attached Notice of Intent to the State.

- 1-No one in Baldwin Town Government recalls receiving the copy of the Notice to the Town at the time. Please inquire of your client as to whether it has any evidence that it was sent as required, and advise.
- 2-Regardless of whether the required notice was sent to the Town at the time, the creation and operation of a rock quarry within the area of the pit previously approved by the planning board <u>only</u> as a gravel pit would appear to exceed the authorized use of the property. Please advise within ten (10) days whether your client will seek an amended (after the fact) approval for the quarrying operation, and if not, why not.

I assume that you must also get approval from SRCC of this operation, and I am therefore copying Dennis Finn on this communication.





Time: I have reviewed the 1989 planning board approval, and am correcting my prior e-mail as some quarrying was approved by the Town.

Therefore, Please ask your client to provide evidence that the Notice was sent as required, and compliance with conditions for quarrying in the excavated area.

NB Condition #8:

"Excavation shall not occur within five feet of the seasonal high water table. Prior to beginning excavation in Phases 2, 3 and 4, Maietta Enterprises, Inc., shall submit to the Planning Board detailed information on the profile of the groundwater within the site as prepared by a groundwater hydrologist. This information shall be tied to a permanent benchmark established on the site and maintained during the operation of the facility."

It is my understanding that water has been observed in the quarried area, indicating that the depth has exceeded the water table. Please advise.
