

MINUTES OF MEETING OF JUNE 25, 1993

MEETING CONVENED AT 8:30 PM. COMMANDER GENE RAMERIZ PRESIDING, ALL OFFICERS WERE PRESENT. THERE WERE 32 MEMBERS PRESENT.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING WERE ACCEPTED AS READ.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

MEMBERSHIP-CHARLES FONTANA REPORTED THAT THE FINAL MEMBERSHIP TOTAL FOR THE YEAR WAS 248. MEMBERSHIP DUES FOR THE 1994 YEAR ARE NOW DUE AND HE HAS RECEIVED A TOTAL OF 25 TO DATE.

BOY'S STATE- FRANK TRIOLA REPORTED THAT HE ATTENDED THE BOY'S STATE MEETING AT CICHON POST ON MONDAY NIGHT. HE WAS INFORMED THAT THE BOY HE SELECTED TO ATTEND BOY'S STATE HAS DECIDED NOT TO ATTEND. HE SAID CHAIRMAN TONY LOCASTO WILL INFORM HIM IF THE POST WILL SPONSOR ANOTHER BOY.

POST ACTIVITIES-CHARLES FONTANA REPORTED THAT A NUMBER OF PROGRAMS ARE BEING PLANNED. IN SEPTEMBER A COMBINED AWARDS NIGHT WITH POST INSTALLATIONS, IN OCTOBER THE ITALIAN NIGHT, NOVEMBER- A BARN DANCE, DECEMBER- CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS PARTY AND NEW YEAR'S EVE PARTY. DETAILED INFORMATION WILL BE ANNOUNCED AS THINGS ARE FINALIZED.

HONOR GUARD-RICHARD REICHAUT STATED THAT NEXT YEAR WILL BE THE 75 ANNIVERSARY OF THE S.I. MEMORIAL DAY PARADE AND THE AMERICAN LEGION WILL BE LEADING OFF THE PARADE. PLANS ARE UNDERWAY TO DO SOMETHING SPECIAL SUCH AS HAVING A BIG FLOAT. MORE INFORMATION ON THIS AS PLANS ARE FORMALIZED.

TREASURER-PAT MERERINDINO MADE A REPORT COVERING MAY 7 TO JUNE 4, 1993. THE OPENING BALANCE WAS \$1,346.61, EXPENSES WERE \$227.08, INCOME \$1082 RESULTING IN A CLOSING BALANCE OF \$2,200.81.
