AKC Rally New Intermediate Class and Introduction the New 2017 Changes



AKC has created a new class and optional title for dogs that have mastered the Rally Novice level class but not yet ready to move up to the Rally Advance level class, which requires the dog to work off-leash. The Rally Intermediate class and associated title (RI), will provide a stepping-stone class to help prepare teams for the off-leash performance required in the Advanced class. The Intermediate course is a mirror image of the Advanced course without a jump.

AKC has also created a new Master class and associated title (RM), as well as the Rally Champion title (RACH), both of which will provide additional challenges for dedicated rally exhibitors.

Class will generally consist of:

- AKC Rally Rules, Regulation, and Exercises changes
- New Novice signs (5)
- New Intermediate & Advance signs (4)
- New Excellent signs (6)
- New Master signs (28)
- Scoring
- Demonstration of each new Exercise/Sign
- Intermediate course runs



Cost: \$55.00 for GPCDFA club members (in good standing) or \$85.00 non-club members.

Prerequisite: Handler being familiar with current [AKC Rally Rules and Regulations](http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/ROR001.pdf) (<http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/ROR001.pdf>) would be helpful but not required. Dogs must have a CGC or completed a basic Obedience course or equivalent.

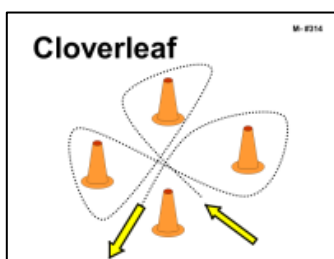
