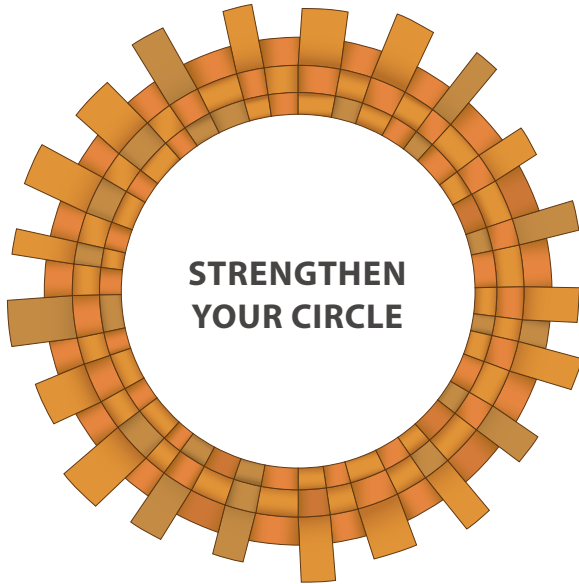

We provide tailored services to enable government, non-profits and private sector organizations to enact reconciliation and to promote decolonization when working with Indigenous peoples.

Core Components of Our Approach:

Personalized: Our programming is tailored to your needs.

Culturally-Grounded: We blend cultural experience, working in partnerships with Indigenous Elders, with delivery of content to create a learning experience that has social, emotional and intellectual impacts.

Action-Oriented: We combine training, review and planning to create a holistic and fulsome approach that will enable the change you desire.

Transformational: Indigenous education is focused on personal development and relationships, and likewise our programs will change participants' perspectives and way of being in the world. This is a deep-dive into learning that impacts the whole person, and therefore the effects will be long-lasting and meaningful.

Cultural Safety: We start from a place of support—free of judgement or blame. We aim to lift up our participants, challenge dominant assumptions and ways of being, and help heal the wounds caused by colonization by bringing Indigenous and non-Indigenous people together in a safe environment to do meaningful work.

Our goal is to support your organization to fully realize a positive, effective, trusting and reciprocal relationship with Indigenous partners.

OUR EXPERIENCE

Our experience includes working with a wide range of organizations, including carrying out community engagement projects, facilitation and research. A sample of our recent, relevant work includes:
