

Ethel Jane Weir, age 94, of Bad Axe, passed away on Wednesday, April 20, 2016. She was born on December 11, 1921 in Onaway, Michigan, only child of the Rev. Robert L. Morton and Bella (Ford) Morton. They moved to Essexville, Michigan and then to Bad Axe in 1932. She has lived in Huron County since that time. Ethel Jane graduated from Bad Axe High School in 1939, from Bay City Junior College in 1944 and from CMU in 1964. She was employed by the Huron County Superintendent of Schools, the Huron County Bureau of Social Aid, and the Huron County Medical Care Facility for 24 years as a Social Worker. She retired on December 31, 1982.

On August 26th, 1967, she married Charles H. Weir at the First Presbyterian Church of Bad Axe. Charlie preceded her in death on March 6, 1987.
