And after: The Amputees and Carers Support Group is an active and dynamic group who meet regularly and organise social events to benefit members.

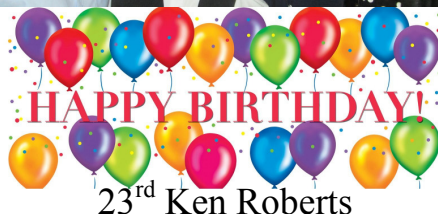

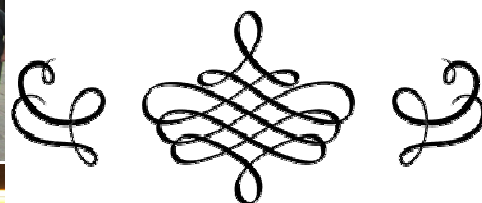

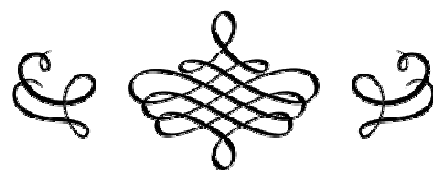
