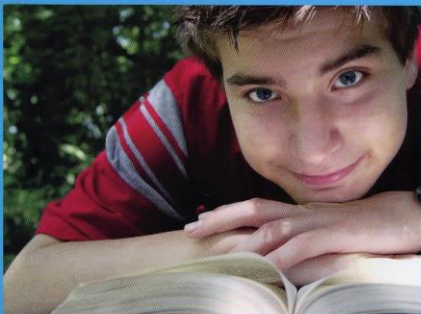

The goal of the program is to develop vital communication skills at an early age, build on and refine these skills as children head toward completion of high school, and assist them in navigating the job market and college, following high school graduation.

Our Services

- **Early Childhood:** Provide Early intervention for children from birth to age five (5), teaching and reinforcing basics in communication skills, including eye contact and appropriate social interaction.
- **School Age:** Refine and build on skills with children as they head toward high school.
- **Transition:** Work alongside, and enrich the services students receive in high school, helping them to develop a transition plan they can take with them into the adult world after graduation.
- **Adult:** Track and assist students as they leave high school, enter college and/or employment, continuing the process through the lifespan.
