Financial Overview

- The Parking Authority had YTD revenue as of July 2023 of \$389,185. This is \$15,458 higher than the previous year. Total YTD expenses were \$264,436. An increase of \$21,506 compared to the previous year. This increase is a result of converting the street meters from 3G modems to 4G modems and unexpected repairs to the vehicles. Net YTD revenue was \$124,749. A decrease of \$6,048 compared to 2022.
- The Park and Ride had YTD revenue as of July 2023 of \$128,399. An increase of \$25,743 compared to 2022. YTD expenses were \$115,253. A reduction of \$23,888 compared to 2022. YTD net revenue was \$13,146 an increase of \$49,631 compared to 2022.
