- **S, Day 1** Depart U.S. for flight to Israel.
- **S, Day 2** Arrive Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport. Transfer to Jerusalem for overnight.



M, Day 3 We will visit the Mt. of Olives; then begin the "Palm Sunday" walk, stopping at Pater Noster Church, commemorating Jesus' teaching His disciples the Lord's Prayer, and Dominus Flevit, and end in

the Garden of Gethsemene, the place of Jesus' agony, betrayal and arrest, and Church of All

Nations, which contains the rock where Jesus is believed to have prayed before His betrayal and arrest. We will also visit Mt. Zion; St. Peter's in Galicantu, which is built over the site of the house of the High Priest Caiaphas and the stone pit



where Jesus was held. Three times, Peter also denied knowing Jesus near this same place. After lunch, visit the Garden Tomb. Overnight in

Jerusalem.



T, Day 4 You will spend the day in the area of Bethlehem and the surrounding hills, visiting Solomon's Pool and Herodian, the palace of

Herod. Continue to Bethlehem; Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field. Lunch at the Grotto. Overnight in Jerusalem. **W, Day 5** Depart hotel. Start the day by visiting the Temple Mount and Western Wall. Visit the Temple Institute. After Junch, continue

to the Dead Sea for floating. Drive north through the Jordan Valley. Overnight in Galilee.

TH, Day 6 Begin the day with a view from Mt. Arbel. Sea of Galilee, including: the Mount of Beatitudes; Tabaha, the



place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Primacy of Peter, Capernaum: known as "Jesus' home town." We will also take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch. Overnight in Galilee.

F, Day 7 Early morning start. Check out of the hotel. Transfer to Jordan via Hussein Bridge. Visit Ajloun - Qa'lat ar-Rabad; The name 'Ajloun goes back to a Christian who lived on this mountain in the Byzan-



tine period. The castle stands on the ruins of a monastery, traces of which were discovered during archaeological excavations. Continue to Mars Elias. 1 Kings, 17: 1 identifies as the residence and possibly even birthplace of the Prophet Elijah. Jabbok River-Jacob crossed the Jabbok on his way to Canaan, after leaving Harran. It leads west to the Sukkot Valley, where Jacob crossed to reach Shechem. The river is first mentioned with the meeting of Jacob and Esau, and the struggle of Jacob with the angel. It was the boundary separating the territory of Gad and Reuben from that of Ammon. The territory of Sihon; "from Arnon unto Jabbok, and it was later taken by the King of Ammon. Overnight in Amman.

- S, Day 8 Visit the ancient city of Jerash-Gergasa which formed part of the Roman province of Syria following General Pompey's conquest of the region in 64 BC. It later became one of the ten cities of the Decapolis league, flourishing and growing wealthier over two centuries of Roman rule. Ancient Philadelphia -Amman City tour; (Under Ptolemy II Philadelphos (285-247 B.C.), Amman was rebuilt and renamed Philadelphia. In 63 B.C., Philadelphia became part of the Decapolis set up by Pompey. It is likely that David's men concentrated their campaign against the city at this point, and perhaps it was here that Uriah was killed at David's order in 2 Sam 11:16-17). Dinner and overnight in Amman.
- **S, Day 9** Visit Bethany Beyond the Jordan; traditional site of Jesus' baptism, Mt. Nebo: where Moses saw the Promised Land, Madaba: one of the towns divided among the 12 tribes of Israel at the time of the Exodus, visit St. George's Church and Mosaic Map depicting all the major biblical sites of the Middle East. Overnight in Petra.
- **M, Day 10** Petra: Tour with the guide to see the Siq, Treasury, Theatre, and Street of Facades. There will be ample free time for you to visit the Royal Tombs, High Place of Sacrifice, and the Monastery, if you should choose. Overnight in Petra.
- **T, Day 11** Early departure from hotel to arrive at Allenby Bridge. Transfer into Israel. You will then have a farewell meal in Jaffa, and enjoy the evening by the Mediterranean Sea or transfer to TLV for return flight to U.S.

W, Day 12 Arrive back to the U.S
