2. Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting

4. Bills against the Commission (refer to file for list of all bills paid)

A motion to pay all bills was made by Andrew Bellone Jr. and was seconded by Mykola Myronowskyj. Please refer to the attached report.

5. Treasurers Report

The next scheduled payment to Wells Fargo for the KME Rescue Truck will be sent. The Board agreed that this payment should be sent priority mail with a signature required. When this payment is received, the late fee that was mistakenly assessed to the account should automatically be removed.

Below please find the excerpt from the March 28, 2017 Commissioners meeting regarding this matter.

The Board received another e-mail from Wells Fargo stating that the account payment was late. I e-mailed the account manager and she reconfirmed that they will have waived the late fee as soon as the next scheduled payment, due March 2018 is received. This e-mail was printed and given to the Treasurer to keep on file. The account manager will look into the system and see if



they can stop the late notices from being generated by their computer as we make a single annual payment and not a monthly payment.

A motion to accept Treasurers report as read was made by Andrew Bellone Jr. and was seconded by Samuel Scapellato.

6. Old Business

There is still as \$2,500.00 grant that was received that was not applied. The Board believes that the funds were for the replacement SCBA's, or for the purchase of the SCBA fit testing machine. The Board forwarded the funds in advance of the grant to pay for the SCBA's. The grant should have been applied to that expenditure. Thomas Bellone Sr. went through the records to determine if this is correct. Thomas was unable to confirm if these funds were for the SCBA grant. Thomas Bellone Sr. will reach out to Ed Paul to find a resolution to this matter.

Scott Graiff has not yet completed his required financial disclosure forms for 2017. Scott was advised that he needs to respond to the e-mail that he was sent and change his password to access his account and complete the required forms.

The Board received a payment summary and the vehicle schedule for the vehicle insurance renewal. The vehicle breakdown that was on the renewal was incorrect. Mykola Myronowskyj reached out to the insurance policy and spoke to Kelly. Kelly was able to make the needed corrections and she sent out the revised policy.

The Commissioners received the different lease options from First Priority. The Board reviewed the options and have agreed that the best option came from Leasing 2 (Option 1). All this information will be sent to Ed Paul from Ball, Buckley & Seher, LLP along with the voter approval from the election to prepare the package for submission to the Local Finance Board.
