

IASMC MidWinter Meeting Minutes April 2, 2016 Daytona Beach, FL

Meeting opened at 10:06 AM by **President LP Brown**. Invocation and Pledge led by Howard Helwig. Welcomes and introductions were conducted including: Wayne Jones CSASMC President, Keith Yocum - FASMC Past Pres, Luke Baker PP of Morocco and on the SEASMC line, David Lohr and other guests from Bahia, and Imperial Sir Gary Berganske.

Secretary Treasurer Jay Alfirevic presented the Treasurers report and it was approved. The treasury is in good shape and bank balance is consistent with this time last year. L.P. Brown appointed Howard, Mike & Dennis to do our audit in Tampa.

Sgt at Arms Rand Seppelin reported that Attendance present included the 7 line officers (LP, Howard, Mike, Dennis, Ed, Rand and Jay), 4 Past Presidents/Officers (Jim Mitch, Woody Woodward, Jack Knight and Past Secy Treas John Anderson) and several members at large. In total 13

Temples were represented with 16 Total Votes Available. Regarding Tampa competition in July Rand noted that the field organized & ready / Parade in YBOR city - Hotel to Comp Field 1 mile / to Parade 9 miles / Parade length 8/10th mile.

Mr Ed Raper, 3rd VP - nothing to report.

Dennis Green, 2nd VP-FASMC Line - FASMC May 4-8 in Orlando sponsored by Bahia. Tickets for "Shoot off " to support FASMC. Trophies - SE moving from trophies to a certificate or plaque in lieu of trophy & donation to be made to hospital. Or plaque or trophy mailed



at a later date. Last year we spent \$2300 on trophies. We had considerable discussion on this. It was decided that we would like to go in this direction, but will first report to the membership for approval in July and implement in 2017. Dennis will further detail this out for presentation at the meeting. Also, Dennis will transport the IASMC trailer from San Antonio to Florida and submit receipts for fuel cost reimbursement.

Mike McLaughlin, 1st VP - commended Rand for all his work. Midwest is alive & well. Summer session was in Fargo & Very active. This year in Marquette first week in August - beautiful riding.

President Elect Howard Helwig - attended FASMC in February and enjoyed. Stayed at Homewood suites in Daytona - our hotel for next year. Looking forward to his year next year. Competing at Speedway. Brunch also at the Speedway. **With support of Imperial - we will move competitions from Monday to Sunday in 2017 & 2018** - get more public to come watch and get more awareness. Radio ads etc. Joint hospitality with FASMC .Car show in Tampa & Daytona 2017 & 2018 - add a new class for Imports. Ability to do Track laps for \$25 & picture options under development. Midwinter meeting & dates March 23-26, 2017 in Williamsburg VA

Wayne Jones introduced. Outgoing President of CSASMC. They have over 1400 paying members with 740 at banquet. Wayne was suggested and approved as the recommended candidate to join our IASMC line this year. The officers and past presidents present unanimously supported this. He will be presented for membership vote and ratification at the General

Membership meeting on July 3rd in Tampa. In addition Wayne is helping to establish a FaceBook page for IASMC to supplement our website. **David Wright, Zem Zem / Mercer County Shrine Club and Luke Baker, Morocco** discussed their interest in joining the line in 2017 and 2018 respectively. They also indicated a willingness to help on below committee in interim.

Expanding IASMC's role to include a new "At Large" Shrine Club, tentatively known as **"Chrome for Kids"** was presented and discussed. The new organization would allow any Noble in good standing to join. This would include motorcycle and car enthusiasts. Various rides and awards would be developed to include visits to Temples and Hospitals throughout North America. This would expand IASMC's role beyond simply running an annual competition. An additional Officer position and advisory group

consisting of regional representatives would be established. Noble David Olson, Yelduz Shrine and former JOW President would initially lead this effort along with Noble Steve Slatas, Kerbella Shrine and others to be identified. Jay Alfirevic was appointed as the current IASMC liaison. Overall this met with a positive reception from all present as a way to broaden visibility and participation to help arow our membership in the Shrine as a whole and within IASMC. Some cautions were also noted to make sure this group is a positive influence. The group would be

intended a "gentlemen's" group with focus on proper attire and wearing of Fez at events when not riding (vs leather vests or patches). Insurance will also need be investigated. The officers will have interim conference calls to further flesh this out with Noble Olson and the others interested in establishing this and a presentation will be made for approval at the General Meeting. A specific motion will be developed and published on the **www.iasmc.net** website by June 2nd to allow 30 days review prior to our July 3rd meeting.

Imperial Sir Gary Berganske discussed upcoming years 2017 and 2018 in Daytona and improvements of \$400 million at the track. He discussed the continuing membership struggle and noted how important the Units and Clubs are to keeping Nobles involved and helping us reverse this trend. He voiced support of the concept of **Chrome for Kids** and encouraged us to pursue it. He presented an overview of some of the plans for Imperial in Daytona with activities at the Bandshell, the parade down A1A, Fireworks, A Sunday "walk for Love", Opportunities to do a lap on the track and other fun stuff. He encouraged us all to carry forward and continue to build our group and support the kids.

Closing prayer was given by Keith Yocum - meeting adjourned at 11:16am.
