Thursday's Special Springer sale was stronger again for the 2nd straight month. Heifers were \$50 to \$75 higher. We again had a very nice quality group springers to offer and prices definitely reflected that. We also sold some horses and equipment on Tuesday in the horse arena. Wilson Farms Percherons and Pro-Motion Belgians (both from Canada) sold 13 hitch geldings. The 6 Percheron geldings averaged \$28,666 with a \$43,000 top.
