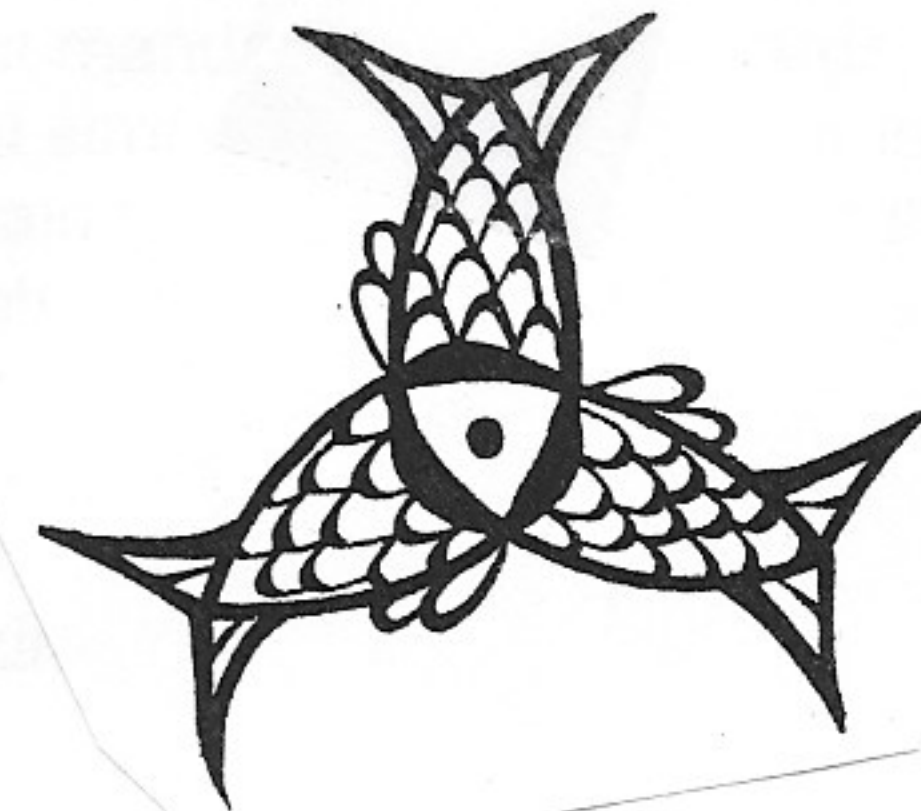

**June 18 ♦ National Eucharistic Revival diocesan-
wide kickoff** – The day will begin at 1 p.m. at St.
Mary's Cathedral and will include speakers,
reflections, small group activities and refreshments.
Opportunities for adoration and confession will be
available. Mass will be celebrated at 5 p.m. with the
bishop and will include a Corpus Christi procession.
The event is free and no registration is required.

CHRISTIAN MOTHERS: Our meeting will be
Thursday, June 16th @ 3 p.m. We support all families
and children with the love of God in their lives. We
also pray the Rosary for deceased members.

In regards to some parishioners requesting **First Friday &
First Saturday Devotions**, we will experiment with having
an 8:30 am Mass rotational "cycle" through all three of our
parishes (...in alphabetical order) beginning July 1st,
2022 to accomplish this desire. We will try having the Mass
@ 8:30 am in the morning (...for that usually works better for
the majority) and have the rotation in alphabetical order so
that all parishes feel involved & equally treated. For
example, next month our First Friday 8:30 am Mass will be
held in Browns Valley on July 1st & our First Saturday 8:30
am Mass will be held in Chokio on July 2nd. The following
month, First Friday 8:30 am Mass will be in Wheaton on
Aug 5th & First Saturday Mass in Browns Valley on Aug
6th. The third month, First Friday 8:30 am Mass in Chokio
on Sept 2nd & First Saturday Mass on Sept 3 in Wheaton.
After three months, the cycle starts all over & repeats itself,
so that each parish has a First Friday & First Saturday Mass
in that time period. This schedule is not guaranteed to
please all attendees, but guaranteed to give it a try; those
who "do" desire to participate are of course going to have to
do some driving. As a bonus & a tie into the devotion
offered for that day, an hour of Eucharistic Adoration will be
available & beginning at 7:30 am on First Fridays & an hour
of confessions will be available & beginning at 7:30 am on
First Saturdays - each in the respective location where the
Mass will be offered that day. Please note that these
devotions are not mandatory in any regards, nor Holy Days
of Obligation, but simply an opportunity for individuals who
would like to obtain the graces & blessings that were
promised in practicing them (...blessings like peace in the
world, peace in one's home, assistance at the hour of one's
death, assistance at the hour of the nonbeliever's death,
etc.) through the Sacred Hearts of Jesus & Mary. More to
