## President's Cup Rules - 2018

- Members must have participated in at least one Men's Club tournament (excluding the Longo/Spoto Memorial Super Bowl Tournament) in 2018 prior to the President's Cup Qualifier held on 3/18/18.
- The 32 lowest net scores of the tournament played on 3/19/18 qualify for the President's Cup Matches. If 28 – 31 players participate, top seeds will receive a bye. If 27 or less participate, 24 will qualify.
- All participants will use their L.I. (Low Index from the prior 12 months) as of 3/15/18 for the duration
  of the matches
- Matches may be played at any agreed upon golf course from the white tees. Disputes between Members about where to play will be settled by a coin flip.
- The first match after the Qualifier must be played by 3/25/18. All following matches must be played in consecutive weeks by Sunday. Be aware that if you win your match, you may be playing every Sunday for several weeks, including Easter Sunday.
- The President's Cup bracket will be posted on the Men's Club website www.CalimesaMensGolfClub.com
- If members can't agree on a date and time to play their match, the default is Sunday morning as close to 8:00 am as possible, contingent on golf course tee time availability. If one or both members can't make Sunday morning, the member or match is forfeited.
- If weather prohibits the play of a match on a Sunday, all matches will be postponed for one week.
- The Member with the higher handicap gets the difference between his handicap and the Member with lower handicap. For example, if a Member has a 16 handicap and is playing a Member with a 10 handicap, the Member with the 16 handicap gets the difference between the two handicaps. The Member with the 16 handicap would get 6 strokes on the 6 most difficult holes and the Member with the 10 handicap would not get any strokes.
- If the match ends in a tie after 18 holes, the match immediately goes into sudden death on the next hole and strokes are given based on the hole's handicap. If a match is played during a tournament and the match started on hole # 13, sudden death starts on hole # 13 using the same handicap differential as the first time the hole was played.
- Members may concede putts to their opponent during matches. If the match is being played during a Men's Club tournament, all putts must be holed in order to remain eligible in the tournament.
- All matches must be posted in accordance the USGA Handicap System Manual. Unfinished holes, conceded strokes/putts or unfinished rounds are not reasons for not posting your score. Please review the <u>USGA Acceptability of Scores</u> flyer.
