Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustee Minutes

September 10, 2019

The Board of Trustees met at the Hampshire Township Administration Offices at 170 Mill Ave., Hampshire, IL on the 10th day of September 2019 at 7:00pm.

- 1) The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag. Mrs. Remakel asked for any additions or corrections to the agenda. There were none.
- 2) Minutes. The Board reviewed the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustee Minutes from August 13, 2019. After reviewing the minutes, a motion was made by Trustee Paddock to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee Bicknese seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously by all those present.
- 3) Treasurer's Report. Mrs. Remakel reviewed the Treasurer's Report. After reviewing the Treasurer's Report, a motion was made by Trustee Feld to approve the Treasurer's Report as presented. Trustee Bicknese seconded the motion and it was approved by all those present. Roll call vote was taken.

4) Reports:

<u>Assessor.</u> Mrs. Letheby reported that there were 14 complaints that went to county on August 16th. The hearings will be on October 19th.

<u>Highway Commissioner.</u> Mr. Walker reported that they have been out hot patching. They have also mowed fence line to fence line. At this time, there isn't much else going on.

Supervisor. Mrs. Remakel reported that she spoke to the developer regarding the proposed senior development and at this time, the development has been put on hold. They are not getting anywhere with the Park District and District 300. The Village knows that we have agreed to not ask for transition fees for this development if they allow us transition fees in all future developments. The senior bus was tested and it passed. More tax money has come in. Mrs. Remakel attended a meeting and learned more about the Ride in Kane program. We currently do not participate in this. We participate in Dial A Ride. Mrs. Remakel explained the difference between these two programs to the Board. She is going to look into if Ride in Kane offers one way trips and if so, would it be cheaper than us transporting a senior both ways.

5) Public Comment. Officer Gartland reported that there have been some building break-ins at the old Shireland property. We explained that there is a new business back there but that is all the info we could provide.

6) Old Business.

<u>TOI Conference Registration.</u> Clerk Marwig informed the board that Supervisor Remakel, Trustee Paddock, Trustee Gustafson, and Assessor Letheby have been registered for the conference.

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7) New Business.

<u>Discussion and Approval of Veteran Memorial donation.</u> At the last meeting, Trustee Gustafson asked the Board if they were interested in donating to the Veteran Memorial that is being built at Seyller Park. At that time, it was not of the agenda for a vote. After some discussion, Trustee Gustafson made a motion to commit a \$2500 donation to the Veterans Memorial in next years' budget. The motion was seconded by Trustee Paddock and approved unanimously by all those present. A roll call vote was taken.
