# **INTRODUCTION**

The report contains alcohol-related information collected in all twenty-three counties in the State of Wyoming for a period of twelve months (January 1 through December 31, 2014 by the Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police. Information was collected from a total of 17,361 persons who were arrested and subsequently detained in a county detention facility. It also includes statistics from persons booked into the VOA Center of Hope in Fremont County.

This report provides detailed county specific alcohol-related information and is a supplement to the <u>Alcohol and Crime in Wyoming –  $2014^1$ </u> report.
