

Construction in Your Neighborhood

Denver Water will be starting a water main replacement project in your area. As Denver Water's infrastructure reaches the end of its useful life, specific water mains in need of replacement are identified to ensure you receive a continuous supply of high-quality water.

As Denver Water provides a critical community service by delivering safe drinking water to our customers, we will continue to operate during COVID-19. Our top priority is to keep employees, contractors and community members safe and healthy, which will allow us to keep serving our customers. We have implemented a variety of safety protocols for our construction crews, including those who will be performing work in your community. When:

- Work is scheduled to begin April 20. We anticipate work will be completed within two months. We will make every attempt to complete this project within the stated timeframe; however, as with any construction project, completion of the work will be heavily dependent on construction schedule and weather.

Where:

- South Quebec Way from East Mississippi Avenue to East Arkansas Avenue

What to Expect:

- Before work begins:
 - "No parking" signs will be posted in the work area.
 - Sandbags will be placed on curb grates to protect stop mud and debris from going into the storm drains.
- During construction:
 - Crews will have equipment stored at the worksite and will work in phases to dig a trench and install the new water main.
 - Street parking will not be available during working hours.
 - Vehicles left in the no parking zone may be subject to tow.
 - Working hours are typically Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-5 p.m.
 - During this time when water service is particularly critical for health and safety, Denver Water is attempting to limit planned water outages. You will be notified in advance of any expected interruptions in water service. However, while it is unlikely, it is possible that emergency water outages may occur.
- Afterward:
 - Restoration including asphalt patching, landscaping and concrete will be completed as weather and contractor schedules allow.
