What Does It Really Mean To Be Impeached

The congressional power to remove a president from office through impeachment is the ultimate control on the president. When a president is impeached there is a process that has to take place, you don't just put the president out of office because they have been impeached. 1. An impeachable offense is considered to be a high crime and or a misdemeanor committed by the president. Some consider it to be an abuse of public trust.

2. Once a president has been impeached there are three committees in the House of Representatives at conduct investigations, gather documents and call on witnesses.

3. The House of Representatives does not have to have an official resolution to launch an impeachment investigation. Even though the House has always has taken a political stand by passing a resolution, it does not have to.

4. Passing a resolution by the House of Representative does not give Congress authority to get grand jury material.

5. The president's lawyers get to participate in the House impeachment

Impeachment

What Does It Really Mean To Be (Continued)

6. The Senate has the sole power to try all impeachments. The Senate is empowered but not required to carry out this function. The Senate rules look at this process as a duty even though it is totally optional.

7. There are three requirements for the Senate to hold trial: The chief-justice presides over the Senate trial, each senator must be sworn in, and a two-thirds vote is required to convict on any article of impeachment.

8. The role of the chief justice is limited even though they are presiding over the trial. The chief justice decides on all evidentiary questions and can put the questions to the full Senate for a vote on admissibility.

9. The president has the power to grant reprieves and pardons for offenses against the United States, except for in the case of impeachment of the president.

10. If the Senate convicts a president through impeachment the president would immediately be removed from office according to the 25th Amendment.
