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
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Counselor

Not a King or a Judge? The New coming Messiah, the Saviour of Israel and of all mankind was to be a Counselor? The Word Counselor means one who gives advice, or one who deliberately consults with another to aid them in some matter. Counseling is described as professional guidance of the individual by utilizing psychological methods, or using various techniques of the personal interview, and testing interests and aptitudes. At any rate, it involves the most personal touch according to Websters dictionary, obviously a

one to one relationship between two persons.

The Apostle Paul speaks of some very real problems in his day that surely exist today in probably larger proportions. I Corinthians 6:9; "Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God; Be not deceived, neither fornicators, nor idolators, not adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor theives, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God?" Also, I Corinthians 2:15, 16, "But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man. For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ." Clearly Paul recognized through the direction of the Holy Spirit, the need to go directly to the One Who could solve that need:

When Christ Himself was on earth in person, some of his Answers to very direct and difficult questions were as

"What Can I Do..." His immediate answer was "Be Born

Again." John 3

"What shall we have ... " Christ's answer to Peter was,"..everlasting life." Matthew 19:29. To the Woman at the Well, His Answer was "Living Water", and to her accusers, this before-unheard of advice, "Go and Sin No More." John 4.

Prophecy proclaims, "For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder; and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace."

God had already tried Judges and Kings to rule his people Israel. The people rebelled, turned away, hardened their heart, and went into captivity because of their unbelief. Now God in His Great Mercy and Love was sending a New Method, something or Someone to deal with the very Heart of mankind. His Son was to be the Counselor. Dr. James C. Wisely Christians can give guidance in many instances, seeking out the Wisdom of God, and searching His Word for answers from above. however, most counseling techniques simply don't work without that Divine intervention. Mere guidelines alone seem futile to the enormous pressures of today's society. For it seems the more counseling that man provides, the more self-help programs he dreams up, just so much more the problems increase around the world.

It is great that the world looks to the church and to the Christians in a real crisis in their lives, and it is needful that some answers be provided, but we who have tasted and shared in the very Presence of the Son of God can go directly to His throne for personal guidance and the Counselor Himself will be the very Jewel of Heaven. He has not remained on earth as a baby, as the world remembers Him at the holiday season, rather He "Ever Liveth to Make Intercession" for every believer.

Jesus Christ will indeed come back to the world as it's King, He indeed will become the Judge of all mankind, but He is presently that significant Advisor to the human heart. in the Wisdom of His Father, he can go directly to the source of the problem with His Healing Balm. in the Eternal Knowledge that He alone possesses, he can go right past all human methods with His Divine Counseling. Parham in the early 1900's. The scripture teaches us to adhere to the truth and proper doctrine. These common doctrinal beliefs are essentially as

Triune God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit

Creation and Formation

Man is basically sinful and in need of Salvation

Salvation by Grace upon repentance toward God and acceptance of Jesus Christ as one's personal Saviour, which is the conception of Spiritual Life.

Sanctification of the Spirit, Soul and Body. A second definite work of Grace by the Lord Jesus Christ.

Baptism of the Holy Spirit; evidenced by speaking in other languages.

Water Baptism (of all believers) by immersion in water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Sacrament of the Lord's Supper.

Washing of Feet.

Divine Healing through Jesus Christ for all believers.

Do not condone divorce and remarriage. Matthew 19:8-9

Destruction of the Wicked. Conditional Immortality.

Rapture of the Man Child Class.

Return of Jesus Christ to earth again; bodily and visibly.

A Ministry supported by tithes and offerings.

These basic doctrines shall be adhered to in the teaching of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, which in addition to other doctrinal teachings approved by the Board from time to time if they are not inconsistent with the above listed basic doctrines.



Cults Are False Prophets By Yvonna Whiteley

CHURCH OF THE LIVING WORD

The Church of the Living Word, sometimes called "The Walk, was founded by John Robert Stevens. The church embraces doctrines from orthodoxy, Assemblies of God and Foursquare denominations, occultism, Eastern religions, and gnosticism.

Adherents of The Walk can supposedly experience "deification, tongues prophecy, healings, auras, and 'transference of powers' in noisy and emotional meetings." Adherents can remain secure in the rigid, authoritarian group structure without having to think for themselves.

Stevens claimed attendance at the American Bible College in Chicago, but there are NO records to show that this school ever existed. He did, however, attend the Foursquare

Life Bible College in Los Angeles.

This new church grew out of a nondenominational church that Stevens started in South Gate, California..in 1954..after having A VISION which he said was comparable to Paul's conversion experience on the Damacus Road. Since 1954, The Walk has grown to 26 churches in California, 51 in rest of U.S. and 22 in foreign countries. He has complete control. The children of followers are educated in 3 special schools, one in Washington, Iowa and the other in the San Fernando Valley, near Los Angeles.

According to Stevens, God has chosen Shiloah (their Iowa headquarters) as the most important spot on the face of the earth: "Shiloah is now the spiritual center of the world, the

beginning of God's creation.

In common with many other cults, the movement is funded through sacrificial offerings of members (many live with other members, pooling their resources and giving all that is left to the church) and through church-owned and operated businesses...like Impact Industries paint roller factory in

Although the Church upholds the Bible as the written word of God, it also believes that the Bible is OUTDATED and must be supplemented by the revelations, writings, and sermons of John Stevens...whose pronouncements are on an

equal par with Scripture.

The Church of the Living Word is claimed to be the only church today which is in God's will. Members of the Walk are said to have come out from Babylon in leaving their denominational ties. Only in The Walk lies salvation, and

claim to be the only "New Testament" church.

It is another cult mark that the importance of the individual members is ignored and the unity of the body, to the exclusion of individuality, is stressed. Steven states: People often try to pigeonhole us to determine what we believe. Actually we start where the Pentecostals, and Holiness groups leave off. We believe that everything spoken in the Scriptures can happen again in our times and through us.

Another cult characteristic shown in this group is the belief that the cult IS BEING PERSECUTED FOR ITS BELIEFS AND THAT GOD in turn will judge those who are in "Babylon" who are doing the persecuting of the "saints" forth. We are NOT against God's people in any way. If they reject the Word that God is bringing forth, they reject us too, because we are bringing forth the Word of this hour. Once they begin to reject us, God takes exception to them...

Stevens claims to be God's apostole for today. His authority is unquestioned and is ranked right along with biblical authority. The Bible is said TO BE MEANINGLESS WITHOUT STEVEN'S Divinely inspired interpretation of it. Followers of the Church of the Living Word must follow the leading of Stevens as though he were God speaking to them.

"God is moving for us to go in to conquer with the sharp two-edged sword ministry under the Captain of the Lord's hosts spoken of in Joshua 5. I am the Captain... I have come to lead you...words from Stevens. He can easily manipulate the Scriptures without fear of detection if his followers refuse to think over what they have heard, content instead to trust him. Remember that the Word of the Lord in this cult's terminology is NOT the Bible, but the Word for Today spoken through Stevens.

Stevens attempts to justify his office of apostle by taking Eph. 4:11-16 out of context and by misinterpreting the word "apostles" in verse 11. He literalizes the figurative speech of II Cor. 3:2,3 in an attempt to justify the continuing "scripture" which he calls a Bible that is increasing. The church's submission doctrine goes far beyond biblical bounds: Stevens urges his followers to follow him and other church leaders EVEN IF THEY ARE WRONG as long as they are

Stevens tells people that membership in the Church of the Living Word carries with it the probability of severe family problems. "One of the first things which happens when you come into this walk is that the Lord does something to your family. Mothers find they can hardly stand their children;

the children are suddenly rebellious...

When we examine the authority and structure of The Walk, in light of the Bible, we find the cult is NOT in harmony with biblical standards for Christ's Church. God will NOT appoint a leader who teaches contrary to what He has already revealed. The scriptures are God's PERFECT WORDS, and anything that purports to be from God MUST BE IN HAR-MONY with these words that He has already said. God has never commanded believers to follow a leader WITHOUT testing him continually with God's already-revealed word. Acts 17:11. Prov. 30:5,6.

Deut. 13:1-5 tells us that IF a prophet CLAIMS to represent God, but TEACHES DOCTRINES ABOUT GOD THAT ARE

HERESY, we are NOT to believe Him.

As we see Stevens teaches the wrong doctrine of God..so we must label him a false prophet and a false apostle. The true apostle of God would invite close scrutiny, and his followers would carefully examine his credentials in the LIGHT OF THE SCRIPTURE (II Cor. 13:3-8)

Just as one Christian would NOT despise another church's work. Jesus taught His disciples to be tolerant of those who were in other bodies and yet were STILL OF THE FAITH.

(Gal. 2:7.. Paul reteaches it).

Although we would REJECT the teachings of The Walk because they err in the essential Bible doctrines of faith, we can still see the inconsistency exhibited by the followers of Stevens who claim to follow the Bible as other churches follow the Bible but who reject all others as part of "Babylon", the biblical symbol for corruption.

We are NOT to renounce reason and we are especially NOT to relegate all thinking to another fallible human being...like

Stevens. II Tim. 3:14-17; II Peter 1:19-21.

The Walk's Doctrine

God:

The church asserts belief in the trinity while at the same time teaching that God is NOT unique since it is the destiny of the church to become God also. The Walk teaches that human deification is possible. "The Lord puts you through a process that will bring you into sonship, into deity... Assume the deity that God wants his people to have...The Word becoming flesh, full of grace and truth...God becoming man means nothing unless we become God...'

The ERRONEOUS teaching that men can become God is totally foreign to the Bible. Isa. 31:3,4 shows the contrast between men and God. Acts 14:15 Paul denies such a belief as it was then being taught by pagans in Lystra. God condemns

such teaching. (Rom. 1:23).

The god of The Walk is changing and growing. The God of the Bible is eternal and separate from His creation (Mal. 3:6; Psa. 102:26,27) Satan was the first to teach that man could be like God (Gen.3:5) God emphatically declared his

uniqueness in Hosea 11:9b.

The teaching that the church becomes God extends to The Walk's eschatology (doctrines of the last things). Stevens teaches that the 2nd coming of Christ has 2 aspects: the literal and the spiritual. The spiritual 2nd coming is NOT a coming at all but is instead the belief that Christ is present in the world through his church, The Walk.

The physical 2nd coming is true as said in Acts 1:11 but that will be just the sign. The principal coming is his coming forth in the persons of His saints, a corporate manifestation of God

in a many-membered body.

The Walk would rob Jesus of His unique title as God the Son, second person of the Trinity. Jesus becomes the church, and we are believers become part of Christ. He is no longer the only-begotten Son of God but is instead some sort of impersonal realm of deity in whose attributes and nature all Christians share. Christ is forever divorced from individuality. The Lord is NO LONGER an individual.

But Christians who stand by the Bible teachings find John 1:14,18 and Matt. 16:16,17 to reveal the truth that there is only 1 Christ. In the orginal Greek text we find tha word "monogenes" which means unique or one of a kind. We are "adopted sons of God...not God or Christ. Rom. 8:23:25 tells us that we do NOT yet have our entire inheritance as adopted sons of God. At the resurrection we will be glorified and will have resurrected bodies like Jesus' body...but we still REMAIN CREATED BEINGS...we will NOT become God. We will worship God and Christ Rev. 21:3,4.

Holy Spirit:

The Walk places great emphasis on the supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit in operation in the church. While Stevens does NOT comment extensively on his theological beliefs concerning the Person and deity of the Holy Spirit, his writings are liberally sprinkled with assertions of the Holy Spirit's moment-by-moment direction of the Walk. He believes that all the supernatural manifestations of the power of the Holy Spirit is being manifested today in his churches. He strongly teaches that the primary function of the Holy Spirit is to bring the divine nature of God into Christians.

Since we will never become God, the Holy Spirit cannot impart deity to us. Peter's statement that we can be "partakers" of the divine nature means that Christians enjoy an initimate spiritual relationship with God as His adopted children. II Peter 1:4; Rom. 8:14-17, John 17:21-23).

It should be clear from our discussion of Deut. 13 that since the church of the Living Word teaches false doctrine...neither the Holy Spirit nor any other member of the Trinity is going to bless Stevens' churches with gifts from God...of whatever kind. Gal. 1:8,9.

Mankind:

The 3 main heresies on the doctrine of man taught by Stevens are all related to the error that man can become God. The Walk teaches that 1) man can become divine; 2) that he can become perfect; 3) that he can become Christ.

In saying that man is divine, Stevens means that Christians share exactly the same nature as God...they become part of God. ".. you're going to be robed with deity itself... God's very nature being reproduced in you..." is what he teaches.

Since man is finite and changing, he can never hope to become infinite and unchanging as Stevens proclaims. It is true that men who are Christians will inherit eternal life but man had a definite beginning so man is not infinite and un-

changing. God is Numbers 23:19.

We can look forward to absolute perfection, or sinlessness, when we become like Jesus at the time of the coming resurrection. Rom. 8:11; I Cor. 15:42-44. But our bodies must be changed and glorified to be made like Christ's resurrection body. Phil. 3:21; Rom. 8:22-25. When Phil. 2:5 tells us to have the mind of Christ, it does not mean that we become Christ. The context of verses 1-11 shows us that Paul is admonishing us to be humble, even as Christ was humble.

Stevens teaches a salvation that is dependent on him and his church rather than on Jesus alone. In his soteriology (teachings about salvation); salvation is a continuing process..administered by Stevens' church and resulting in deification of its members. Like most cults, The Walk adds to the Bible's simple declaration that salvation is completely by grace...apart from works. (Eph. 2:8-10; I Tim. 2:5)

Stevens teaches that God accepts or rejects people in different degrees. God accepts the beliver on the level he determines to live on. You determine the limitations of your relationship to God by what is within you. We do NOT walk into the Kingdom: we do NOT fight or preach into it...we simply become so full we start overflowing and FLOAT into the

Kingdom..."

Their salvation is also accomplished through the offices of the church. He teaches that his leaders can transfer the people's guilt to Christ and transfer the innocence of Christ to the guilty. "Your shortcomings are of no significance at all, because you can reach up and touch Him through the

ministry of the priesthood and be cleansed."

Stevens teaches that we will be saved from our human and changed into nonpersonal divine natures..."something must first be wrought in your nature so that you will to be a child of God and NOT a human being. Therefore the Lord puts you through a process that will bring you into sonship, into deity... Assume the deity that wants for you."

The Bible is emphatic in declaring that salvation is in NO way connected to any efforts on our part. Eph. 2:8-10. There is NO man on this earth, NO church that has ever existed, that can participate in a person's salvation...it's accomplished entirely by God through Jesus. I Tim. 2:5; Heb. 7:25; Heb. 1:1,2).

So The Walk teaches error on almost all the essential doctrine of the Christian faith. Stevens' theology can't meet the

test of biblical truth.

Nothing unclean can enter in Where God in glory reigns; His eyes so pure cannot endure The sight of spots and stains.

Nothing unclean must stand between The Holy One and me; Saviour from sin, Thy work begin, Wash me til Thou canst see Nothing unclean.
