
## Frederick Arnold Carr 1935 – 2023



Fred was born in Newcastle on February 15, 1935, to his parents Leo Charles Carr and Mary Agnes Brennan Carr. He was raised in the Newcastle area and attended Newcastle schools graduating in 1953.
