# **Exploring Romans**

Paul's letter to the Romans is quite different than any of his other letters, in which he offers pastoral or theological advice to people he knows personally. Paul did not start or plant the



church in Rome. In fact at the time the letter was written, Paul had not yet visited Rome. Therefore, in Romans Paul offers more "general" statements about the nature of sin, the promise of salvation, and the call to mission. In other words, Paul addresses many of the important questions that arise when one considers the relationship between God and creation.

We will explore the letter to the Romans in 6 sessions. Session 3—"If what I do doesn't save me, does it matter how I live?" May 2nd—1:30 pm at Concordia Session 4—"Where is God when we suffer?" May 6th—6:30 pm at Redeemer May 9th—1:30 pm at Concordia Session 5—"How can I keep from singing?" May 13th—6:30 pm at Redeemer May 16th—1:30 pm at Concordia Session 6—"What does God want from us?" May 20th—6:30 pm at Redeemer May 23rd—1:30 pm at Concordia
