


120 Registered Show Cars and \$2,050 for Charity! Sweetheart Cruise-In a "Sweet" Success

Join or Support "Team Cool Cruisers for a Cure" Susan G. Komen 5K Race for the Cure



Team "Cool Cruisers for a Cure" is up to 6 team members (welcome, Wendy Bailey!!), so we're looking for at least 4 more to join the team. We need to have 10 registered team members by **May 13th** to be considered a team for the Race. Team members are not required to physically participate on Race Day, so you can join even if you're not sure you'll be in town for the Race. The Race is on **Saturday, May 13th at 8:00 am**.

The Race is a walk/run that leaves from Lenox Mall, loops for 3.1 miles (5K) and ends back at Lenox Mall. Komen Atlanta does not require fundraising for the Race but we'd like all team members to commit to raising \$125 each. Team members who work a GCC event that fundraises for the Race will split the donations. Our Team is currently #1 in fundraising! Rick is currently #3 for individual fundraising, Sharon is #4 and Donna is #9.

75% of the money raised by the Race for the Cure stays in the 13-country metro Atlanta Area to help women and men get breast care services they need, 25% goes to Komen National for breast cancer research.

Registration is currently \$30 for adults and survivors, \$20 for youth (age 12 and under), Sleep in for the Cure is \$50. Registration fees go up by \$5 on March 1st, so register by February 28th to avoid the increase. *Contact Sharon at 404-732-6843 is you have any questions about the Race for the Cure.*
