If you or anyone in your household receives Social Security administered benefits or Massachusetts State Supplemental Payments SSP you are required to provide a benefit letter dated within the last 60 days.

<u>Do not send the notice or Form 1099 you received in December of last year!</u>

Instructions Regarding your Federal Social Security (SS), Social Security Disability Income (SSDI), and Supplemental Security Income (SSI)benefits

<u>Social Security Verification</u> – please request a "**Proof of Income Letter**" from SSA's website or call the toll-free number.

- **SSA's website**, go to <u>ssa.gov</u>. From the left side bar, select "What can you do online"; select "If you get benefits"; then select "Request a <u>Proof of Income Letter</u>". Tenants should check the box "All Benefit Information Available":
- Call the <u>National</u> toll-free **1-800-772-1213**. This information is free and the tenant should receive the letter in the mail within 10 days. You will need to make a <u>separate phone call for each person</u> receiving benefits. <u>It only takes 10-12 minutes per call</u>; **or**
- Call the <u>local Gardner office</u> **1-844-371-8116**. During this time of COVID-19 pandemic, the local office is <u>NOT OPEN</u> to the public. Call them to "Request a <u>Proof of Income Letter</u>".

Once you receive this letter, please mail <u>all pages</u> to this office in the Self-Addressed Envelope (SAE) provided or drop-off at the office.


