## **INSTRUCTIONS for completing the Transfer of Ownership**

- 1 Enter the registration number and registered name as it appears on the registration certificate; Date of Sale is date the horse actually changed ownership.
- 2 Indicate whether the animal to be transferred is an unregistered foal, mare, stallion, gelding, or yeld/spayed mare
- 3 To transfer an unregistered foal, enter the year of foaling and the dam's name & registration number.
- 4 If the animal to be transferred is a mare, indicate whether:
- a. she is being sold "open" or "bred". If she was bred prior to date of sale, but had not yet foaled, enter the last date bred, and the registered name and registration number of the sire (along with name of registry, if not ICBR)
- b if she is sexually mature (whether intact or has now been spayed) and eggs or embryos have been retained by the seller, the number of these must be declared.
- 5 If the animal being transferred is a stallion (or has now been gelded) and semen has been retained by the seller, the number of straws must be declared.
- 6 Print the name(s) of the buyer(s) as it should appear on the record of ownership. Enter buyer's correct mailing address. If joint ownership, enter all owners' names. Obtain the signature(s) of the buyer if present at the time of the sale.
- 7 Enter printed name(s) of seller as it appears on registration certificate of animal to be transferred. Enter mailing address for all recorded owners at the time of sale. Obtain signature(s) of seller (all recorded owners must sign as seller). Refer to rule #3.02 8 If animal to be transferred has registration application pending, awaiting DNA analysis, a transfer form may be completed and returned with fee, so that when the original certificate is issued the papers will go directly to the buyer.
