USA Uniform Policy

Please remember that proper uniform is essential to your appearance as a professional umpire (and that failure to wear proper uniform may result in loss of game fees!). Since the leagues we service and most of the tournaments we work are USA-sanctioned, NVSUA follows the USA uniform policy (scanned from page 114 of the 2016 Rule Book):

Section 5 UNIFORM

The male and female umpire shall wear:

- A. A powder blue or navy blue, short-sleeved polo shirt. ASA letters are worn on the left chest of the polo shirt.
- B. Approved navy blue or heather gray slacks with navy or black socks.
 C. The approved navy cap with white ASA letters, trimmed with light blue on
- C. The approved navy cap with white ASA letters, trimmed with light blue on the front and the US Flag positioned on the left side, with the stars forward.
- D. The approved navy blue ball bag with ASA letters to be worn with either navy or heather gray slacks. The approved gray ball bag(s) with ASA letters may be worn with heather gray slacks.
- E. The approved navy jacket with white ASA letters on the left chest,
- F. Black shoes and belt.
- G. A t-shirt is optional to wear under the powder blue or navy blue polo shirt; If a t-shirt is worn, it shall be a white t-shirt under the powder blue polo shirt and navy t-shirt under the navy blue polo shirt.
- H. The plate umpire in fast pitch SHALL wear a black or silver mask, with black or tan padding and a black throat protector. (An extended wire protector may be worn in lieu of a throat protector on the mask.)

To reduce personal expenses to our umpires, NVSUA has just one standard uniform: powder blue USA shirt, standard USA hat, navy blue USA ball bag. The alternate uniform (navy blue shirt) may be worn if working alone, or if approved by the acting UIC at a tournament.
