#### Lawn Maintenance (mowing) & Cutting

- Cut up a tree that had fallen at the corner of Dayton Liberty Rd. and Rossiter Dr.

#### Equipment Maintenance/Repairs

- Started servicing mowers for the winter, sharpen blades, grease fittings looking for missing or lose nuts and bolts, weak or bad batteries etc.
- Temporary weld on hydraulic clutch pump on truck 2
- Welded up grate for truck 2

#### Road Maintenance/Repairs

- Plowed and salted roads throughout the Township
- used 25 tons , more or less of salt for ice and snow control
- filled in potholes on Derby Rd, Kimmel Rd, Infirmary Rd, Pinnacle Rd, and Paw Tuckett St. near dollar store it was with rocks and packing gravel
- replaced down sign on Knapp Ave. that was a; fire lane no parking sign.

#### Trash Pick-up

- Picked up trash at Town Hall near recycling bins and across the road
- Trash pickup on Calumet Ln. from Third St. to the 200 block on both sides of the road
- Picked up dead animal on Tenshaw Dr. and had one picked up on the West end St.

#### Miscellaneous

- Disconnected battery from zoning truck and put it on charge at Road Dept.
