ANNOUNCEMENT BISHOP TERESA JEFFERSON-SNORTON, CHAIR, CME BOARD OF CHAPLAINS

The CME Board of Chaplains, under the leadership of Bishop Teresa Snorton (CME Endorsing Agent), will host its regular breakfast meeting on Wednesday, January 17, 2016 at 6:30 am and its **quadrennial retreat** on **Friday-Saturday morning, January 19-20, 2018** for all endorsed chaplains, chaplains/ministers in specialized settings and any other interested persons. These events are in conjunction with the Phillips School of Theology Pastors' Conference and Founder's Day Celebration and will be held at The Westin-Atlanta Airport, 4736 Best Road, Atlanta, GA 30337. The Retreat begins on Friday at 4 p.m. and ends on Saturday at 10:00 a.m.

Retreat registration is \$75 for dues paying members and \$100 for all others, includes resource materials and meals. Deadline for registration is December 31, 2017.

The facilitators for the Retreat will be Bishop Teresa E. Jefferson-Snorton, Reverend Lawrence Jefferson-Snorton, and Dr. Urias Beverly. Bishop Jefferson-Snorton is the 59th Bishop of the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church, Ecclesiastical Endorsing Agent for the CME Church, and the Presiding Bishop of the Fifth Episcopal District which includes the states of Alabama and Florida. She is a certified Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE Supervisor) and a board-certified Chaplain with the Association of Professional Chaplains.

Reverend Lawrence Jefferson-Snorton, Administrative Dean of the Academy for Pastoral Theology, a biblical and theological program for ministers and laypersons in the Fifth Episcopal District. He has four decades of ministry experiences within the Christian Methodist Episcopal Church. A graduate of The Interdenominational Theological Center, and currently pursuing his Doctor of Ministry degree at Payne Seminary, Wilberforce, Ohio.

Dr. Urias Beverly, Director of the Doctor of Ministry Program and Muslim Chaplaincy Programs, and an Associate Professor of Pastoral Care and Counseling at Ecumenical Theological Seminary. He is the Past President of the Association of Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE). He is the author of the Places You Go: Caring for Your Congregation Monday Through Saturday.
